Shalom one and all!

Here we are in the month of Adar! This year an extra month is added to the Jewish Calendar to keep the solar and lunar calendar in sync as God commanded. Therefore we have an Adar 1 and an Adar 2. Did you know Moses died on the 7th of Adar, which is Friday, Feb 7th this year? According to Deuteronomy 34:8 we read that the Jews mourned his passing for 30 days. Then, after the 30-day mourning period we find God tells Joshua:

Joshua 1:1,2 Now after the death of Moses the servant of the LORD, it came to pass that the LORD spoke to Joshua the son of Nun, Moses' minister, saying, Moses my servant is dead; now therefore arise, go over this Jordan, you, and all this people, to the land which I do give to them, even to the children of Israel.

We see this will take 3 days:

Joshua 1:11 Pass through the host and command the people, saying, Prepare you victuals; for within three days you shall pass over this Jordan, to go in to possess the land, which the LORD your God gives you to possess.

And then we find:

Joshua 4:19 And the people came up out of Jordan on the tenth day of the first month, and encamped in Gilgal, in the east border of Jericho.

So if we subtract 33 days from the 10th of Nisan you come up with the 7th of Adar.

We also can see Adar 7 was Moses' birthday:

Deuteronomy 31:1,2 And Moses went and spoke these words to all Israel. And he said to them, "I am an hundred and twenty years old this day; I can no more go out and come in: also the LORD has said to me, 'You shall not go over this Jordan.' "

So Friday, Feb 7th 2014 is Moses' birthday and also the day he died.

We will be having our Passover Seder at Pacific Lutheran University and tickets will be available this next week. We also have our brand new calendar known as the "Official Biblical Blood Moon Eclipse Calendar" coming available in just a few weeks! 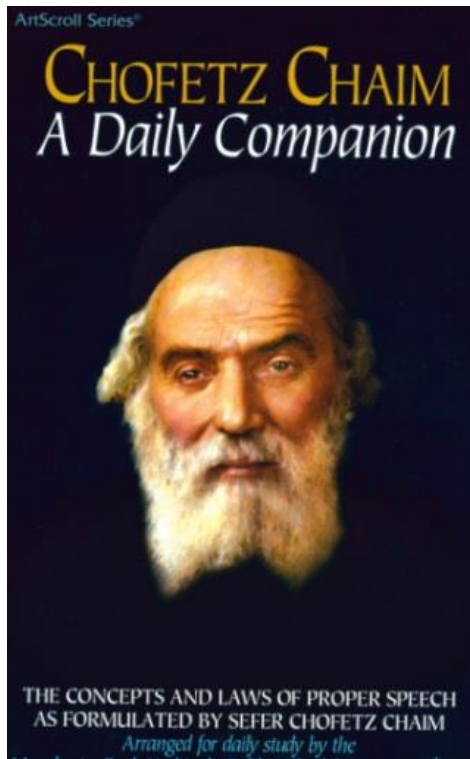

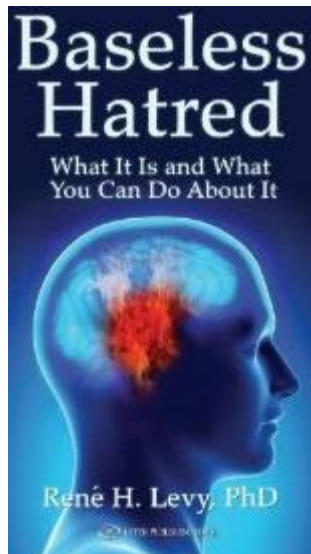

Slow Cooked White Chili

Ingredients

3/4 pound skinless, boneless chicken breast halves - cubed 1 medium onion, chopped 1 garlic clove, minced 1 tablespoon vegetable oil 1 1/2 cups water 1 (15 ounce) can white kidney or cannellini beans, rinsed and drained 1 (15 ounce) can garbanzo beans, rinsed and drained 1 (11 ounce) can whole kernel corn, drained 1 (4 ounce) can chopped green chilies 1 teaspoon chicken bouillon granules 1 teaspoon ground cumin

Directions

In a large skillet, sauté chicken, onion and garlic in oil until onion is tender. Transfer to a slow cooker. Stir in the remaining ingredients. Cover and cook on low for 7-8 hours or until chicken juices run clear and flavors are blended.

Delicious Crockpot Apple Crisp

Ingredients:

6 cups thin-sliced Granny Smith apples, peeled 2/3 cup packed brown sugar 1/2 cup apple cider 1/2 cup flour 1/2 cup quick-cooking oats 1 tsp. ground cinnamon 1/2 cup butter

Directions:

Start cooking your apples in the slow cooker. In a small bowl, mix the brown sugar, flour, apple cider/juice, oats and cinnamon. With a hand mixer, cut in the margarine until the mixture looks like coarse crumbs. Sprinkle all that over the apples. Cover and cook on low for 3 hours or until apples are tender. Decorate with a dollop of whip cream and a mint sprig!

This Month in History

This year on the Hebrew calendar there is an extra month, Adar I, called a leap month. When this happens there is no Jewish History for the month because it will not always show up. So any history for the month of Adar will be in Adar II when you have a leap month like this year.
