### Message from Pastor Mark

Shalom one and all!!

What exciting times we live in! You have been called for such a time as this. You could have been born anytime in history but God thought it best that someone with all of your characteristics was needed for this generation that will herald the coming of the Messiah!

The generation in the wilderness was known as the generation of no faith. Yet that generation saw more miracles than any other generation in human history. What happened to them is to serve as an example for us. So we learn from history that miracles do not produce faith! Yeshua said when He comes back will He find faith on earth. Yet the false prophet will perform many miracles and the multitudes will follow. God is looking for a generation whose faith produces actions.

We live in the same times as Elijah!

1Ki 18:21 And Elijah came unto all the people, and said, How long halt ye between two opinions? If the LORD be God, follow him: but if Baal, then follow him. And the people answered him not a word.

We are entering an Elijah moment. There's always been a remnant who has not bowed the knee to baal. He was not upset at the baal worshipers who were not a part of Israel but all the baal worshipers who were a part of Israel!

Every valley shall be exalted, and every mountain and hill shall be made low: and the crooked shall be made straight, and the rough places plain: And the glory of the LORD shall be revealed, and all flesh shall see it together: for the mouth of the LORD hath spoken it.

The Bible says to give God no rest till He makes Jerusalem a praise in the earth.

Isa 62:6,7 I have set watchmen upon thy walls, O Jerusalem, which shall never hold their peace day nor night: ye that make mention of the LORD, keep not silence. And give him no rest, till he establish, and till he make Jerusalem a praise in the earth.

It is time for believers, those that make mention of the Lord, to not keep silent! For those congregations who dare to take a stand only for the God of Israel ask your congregational leader to take 60 seconds on Aug 13th or 14th and read the greatest commandment from the Torah as spoken by Yeshua.

## "THE DIRE STRAITS"

For a total of eight hundred and thirty years there stood a structure on a Jerusalem hilltop that served as the point of contact between God and man, Heaven and Earth. So central was this edifice to the relationship between man and God that nearly two-thirds of the 613 commandments are contingent upon its existence. Its destruction is regarded as the greatest tragedy of Israel's history, and its rebuilding will mark the ultimate redemption-the restoration of harmony within God's creation and between God and His creation.

July 19, 2011 is the 17th Day of the Jewish month of Tammuz. On you Jewish calendars it is designated as the "Fast of Tammuz". This marks the beginning of what the Jews call the "Three Weeks" or "Dire Straits" which ends on "Tisha B'Av", the 9th of Av which is August 9th this year. These three weeks are designated as a time of mourning over the destructions of the Holy Temple and the resultant physical exile and spiritual displacement in which the Jewish people still find themselves.

The term "Dire Straits" is based on the verse (Lamentations 1:3) which states: "All of [Israel's] pursuers overtook her between the straits." Jewish tradition explains that "between the straits" refers to the days of affliction between the seventeenth of Tammuz and the ninth of Av. In this period, many calamities befell the Jewish people throughout their generations. It was during this period of between the straits that both the first and second Temples were destroyed, 600 years apart.

During this period, many Jewish people lessen the extent of their rejoicing. They don't:

- Conduct weddings.
- Play musical instruments or listen to music.
- Recite the *Shehecheyanu* blessing.
  - Blessed are you, Lord, our God, king of the universe who has kept us alive, sustained us, and enabled us to reach this season (Amen)
- Because of this, they do not wear new clothing
- The do not eat fruit which they have not yet eaten this season so that they will not be required to recite *Shehecheyanu*.
- They do not get a haircut or shave.

However, all the laws of mourning are suspended on Shabbat. The fast days are postponed until Sunday, and the Shabbat is joyously celebrated. Why is all mourning suspended on Shabbat? We believe that every Shabbat constitutes a foretaste of the Messianic Era. As such, on Shabbat we only focus on the positive elements of life and the Jews also do so for the positive elements of this period. Jews believe that with the coming of the Messiah they will understand that all the suffering was necessary in order to reach the ultimate good.

The prophet Jeremiah foretold that Messiah would transform their sorrowful days into days of joy "*I will turn their mourning into joy and will comfort them and make them rejoice from their sorrow*" (Jeremiah 31:12).

The Three Weeks should be a time of increased Torah study and giving of charity

During this period they spend extra time contemplating the less-than-perfect state the world is in now and what they can do to improve it by increasing in deeds of goodness and kindness.

The Three Weeks should be a time of increased Torah study and giving of charity– in keeping with the verse Isa 1:27 "Zion shall be redeemed with judgment, and her converts with righteousness." Particularly, they are encouraged time and again the study of those portions of Torah that deal with the building of the Holy Temple.

It is our generation in particular, that stands on the threshold of redemption, that should study with the awareness that these promises will be even more practical in the near future! There is more to the Three Weeks than fasting and lamentation. The prophet describes the fasts as "days of goodwill before God"-days of opportunity to take advantage of the failings of the past as the inspiration for a renewed and even deeper bond with God. A sense of purification accompanies the fasting, a celebration of redemption overshadows the mourning, and a current of joy supersedes the sadness.

YOUTH CORNER  
Teens and Torah

....in the Way that he should go.

Proverbs 22:6 Train up a child *in the way he should go*: and when he is old, he will not depart from it.

We may have read this from Proverbs or heard it in church many times, but exactly what is “in the way he should go”. In some churches that may mean sitting in a pew with your parents for a half hour lecture or joining others kids in youth ministry watching videos or playing games. But God has some very specific things in mind regarding the instruction of children.

Rabbi Shaul (Apostle Paul) reminded Timothy about his upbringing:

2Timothy 3:14-15 "But continue thou in the things which thou hast learned and hast been assured of, knowing of whom thou hast learned them; And that from a child thou hast known the holy scriptures, which are able to make thee wise unto salvation through faith which is in Yeshua HaMashiach".

Paul reminded Timothy that from “*a child thou hast known the holy scriptures*”. What scriptures were those? The gospels and epistles hadn’t even been written or circulated as of yet. Yet Rabbi Shaul mentions that they are “*able to make these wise unto salvation through faith in Yeshua HaMashiach*” (Jesus Christ).

The scriptures he is referring to is the Tanakh. The Torah, Psalms and prophets that Yeshua himself learned from. Hebrew parents put great emphasis on education in the home... but it wasn’t entertainment. Their first line of business and responsibility was the education of their children.

God made it clear what Abraham’s intentions were and his faithfulness to this precept:

Genesis 18:19 "**For I know him**, that he will **command his children** and his household after him, and **they shall keep the way of the LORD**, to do justice and judgment; that the LORD may bring upon Abraham that which he hath spoken of him".

The way of education for Hebrew children was synonymous with Torah. That was their guideline. It was practical and spiritual in nature, and allowed children to live life and experience what they were learning to the fullest degree. Memorization and repetition of Scripture was vitally a centerpiece.

My daughter recently returned from the Land of Israel where she had the opportunity to visit some Yeshiva’s (Hebrew school). She was amazed at the various method’s used to memorize the scriptures (such as singing the scriptures) It was a unified and community effort, and the mindset was certainly Hebraic in nature and not western thought. What’s the difference?

Western thought and teaching can many times be static...such as sitting and listening to a teacher in a lecture setting which is a perfect scenario for a child to woolgather (space out). Hebraic thinking and teaching is dynamic...where a child is involved in an activity from which they learn.

At El Shaddai Ministries the youth are taught the Hebrew alphabet starting at age 2. Children just don’t sit and listen, but are actively engaged. Reciting the alphabet together to the congregation boosts their confidence. Later in other age groups they learn words and then phrases in Hebrew, particularly the Names of God. This helps vitally in their understanding of the Torah.

Would you rather have your child being Westernly passive, TV obsessed, entertainment prone and a spectator?, or energetic, robust and dynamic in community activity? In your home, or Youth ministry get your children involved in activity that they must do to learn, and the lessons from “training up a child” will show forth fruits of righteousness in years to come. ## FAST-FUN-FACTS

Five great catastrophes occurred in Jewish history on the 17th of Tammuz:

1. Moses broke the tablets at Mount Sinai — in response to the sin of the Golden Calf.
2. The daily offerings in the First Temple were suspended during the siege of Jerusalem, after the Kohanim could no longer obtain animals.
3. Jerusalem's walls were breached, prior to the destruction of the Second Temple in 70 CE.
4. Prior to the Great Revolt, the Roman general Apostamos burned a Torah scroll - setting a precedent for the horrifying burning of Jewish books throughout the centuries.
5. An idolatrous image was placed in the Sanctuary of the Holy Temple - a brazen act of blasphemy and desecration.

## RECIPES

Warm Chicken Ranch Wraps

Ingredients:

- 8 skinless, boneless chicken breasts
- 1 cup water
- 1 cup cooked rice
- 1/2 cup ranch-style salad dressing
- 1 cup buttermilk
- 1 cup all-purpose flour
- 1 teaspoon salt

- 1/4 teaspoon ground black pepper
- 1 cup vegetable oil
- 8 (10 inch) flour tortillas
- 2 cups shredded lettuce
- 2 tomatoes, chopped

Directions:

1. Cut chicken breast into strips.
2. Grilled chicken method: Spray a large skillet with nonstick cooking spray. Add chicken, cook over medium-high heat 12 to 15 minutes, or until light brown and juices run clear. Add the water and bring to a boil. Add the rice, cover and remove from the heat and let stand for 5 minutes. Stir in the salad dressing.
3. Fried Chicken Method: Dip chicken into buttermilk then roll them in the flour mixture. Fry for 3 minutes each side in a 350 degrees F (175 degrees C) skillet with 1 cup of oil in it. Combine the fried chicken strips and the cooked rice pilaf. Stir in the salad dressing.
4. Fill each warm tortilla with lettuce, chicken and rice mixture, and tomatoes. Fold in both sides of the wrap. Holding in the folded sides roll the wrap tightly from the bottom to the top, keeping the ingredients firmly packed as you go. Slice each wrap in half diagonally and serve.

### Refreshing Summer Orzo Salad

Ingredients:

- 4 cups chicken broth
- 1 (16 ounce) package orzo pasta
- 1 1/2 tablespoons butter
- 1/4 cup extra-virgin olive oil
- 1 1/2 teaspoons minced garlic
- 1/2 teaspoon dried basil
- 1/2 teaspoon dried thyme
- 1/4 teaspoon crushed red pepper flakes
- 1 cup pine nuts
- 1 cup pitted kalamata olives
- 1 (2 ounce) jar capers, with liquid
- 12 ounces basil-flavored feta cheese
- 1 (10 ounce) bag fresh spinach leaves, chopped
- 1 tablespoon lemon juice

Directions

1. Bring the chicken broth to a boil over high heat. Add the orzo pasta, and cook until all dente, 8 to 10 minutes. Drain well, then pour the orzo into a bowl, and toss with the butter to keep it from sticking; set aside.
2. While the pasta is cooking, heat the olive oil in a skillet over medium heat. Stir in the garlic, and cook until the garlic softens and the aroma mellows, about 2 minutes. Stir in the basil, thyme, red pepper flakes, and pine nuts. Cook and stir until the pine nuts have toasted to a light golden brown.
3. Stir the pine nut mixture into the orzo along with the olives, capers, feta cheese, spinach, and lemon juice. Serve either warm or cold, but it's better the next day.

### Annie's Fruit Salsa and Cinnamon Chips

Ingredients:

- 2 kiwis, peeled and diced
- 2 Golden Delicious apples - peeled, cored and diced
- 8 ounces raspberries
- 1 pound strawberries
- 2 tablespoons white sugar
- 1 tablespoon brown sugar
- 3 tablespoons fruit preserves, any flavor
- 10 (10 inch) flour tortillas
- butter flavored cooking spray

Directions:

1. In a large bowl, thoroughly mix kiwis, Golden Delicious apples, raspberries, strawberries, white sugar, brown sugar and fruit preserves. Cover and chill in the refrigerator at least 15 minutes.
2. Preheat oven to 350 degrees F (175 degrees C).
3. Coat one side of each flour tortilla with butter flavored cooking spray. Cut into wedges and arrange in a single layer on a large baking sheet. Sprinkle wedges with desired amount of cinnamon sugar. Spray again with cooking spray.
4. 4.Bake in the preheated oven 8 to 10 minutes. Repeat with any remaining tortilla wedges. Allow to cool approximately 15 minutes. Serve with chilled fruit mixture.

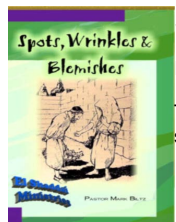

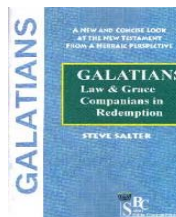
### **Spots, Wrinkles and Blemishes**

Law & Grace, Companion in Redemption

For far too long the book of Galatians has been interpreted as the Epistle that is against the Torah (Instructions).
