

Simple Sukkah for about \$50.

Materials:

14 – 2"x2"x8' (Hem-Fir) about \$2 each

14 – 1"x2"x8' (Hem-Fir) about \$1.25 each

48 – 2 ½" drywall screws (Price varies on screws)

26 – 1 ½" drywall screws

Pre drill all wood (probably 1/8" – will vary with screw used)

I used 7 - 2"x2"s full length (8') for top and sides

I cut 4 – 2"x2"s to 7' for uprights

(easier to reach vegetation on roof/your choice on height)

I cut 3 - 2"x2"s up for knee braces at 45 degrees angles on each end

That will make 15 knee braces, each 1.5' long (18")

You can always use more if you need them (winds, free standing, etc.)

I used 14 – 1"x2"s full length (8')

(you may have to cut 3 down for sides and back depending

on if your knee braces interfere)

You may want to use some kind of fabric for the sides.

You may want to fasten Sukkah to a stationary object.
