Genesis 22:2-4 And he said, Take now your son, your only son Isaac, whom you love, and get you into **the land of Moriah**; and offer him there for a burnt offering on one of the mountains which I will tell you of. And Abraham rose up early in the morning, and saddled his ass, and took two of his young men with him, and Isaac his son, and split the wood for the burnt offering, and rose up, and went to the place of which God had told him. Then on the third day Abraham lifted up his eyes, and saw the place afar off.

1Chronicles 21:18,20 Then the angel of the LORD commanded Gad to say to David, that David should go up, and set up an altar to the LORD in the threshing floor of Ornan the Jebusite. And Ornan turned back, and saw the angel; and his four sons with him hid themselves. Now Ornan was threshing wheat.

2Chronicles 3:1 Then Solomon began to build the house of the LORD at Jerusalem in **mount Moriah, where the Lord appeared** to David his father, in the place that David had prepared in the threshing floor of Ornan the Jebusite.

Micah 4:11-13 Now also many nations are gathered against you, that say, Let her be defiled, and let our eye look on Zion. But they know not the thoughts of the LORD, neither understand they his counsel: for he shall gather them as the sheaves into the floor. Arise and thresh, O daughter of Zion: for I will make your horn iron, and I will make your hoofs brass: and you shall beat in pieces many people: and I will consecrate their gain to the LORD, and their substance to the Lord of the whole earth.

Matthew 3:12 Whose fan is in his hand, and he will thoroughly purge his floor, and gather his wheat into the garner; but he will burn up the chaff with unquenchable fire.

Genesis 23:1 And the life of Sarah is a hundred and twenty and seven years--years of the life of Sarah; (YLT)

Genesis 23:2 and Sarah dieth in Kirjath-Arba, which is Hebron, in the land of Caanan, and Abraham goeth in to mourn for Sarah, and to bewail her. (YLT)

Genesis 23:10-16 And Ephron עֶפְרוֹן dwelled among the children of Heth: and Ephron עֶפְרוֹן the Hittite answered Abraham in the audience of the children of Heth, even of all that went in at the gate of his city, saying, No, my lord, hear me: the field give I you, and the cave that is therein, I give it you; in the presence of the sons of my people give I it you: bury your dead. And Abraham bowed down himself before the people of the land. And he spoke to Ephron עֶפְרוֹן in the audience of the people of the land, saying, But if you will give it, I pray you, hear me: I will give you money for the field; take it of me, and I will bury my dead there. And Ephron עֶפְרוֹן answered Abraham, saying to him, My lord, listen to me: the land is worth four hundred shekels of silver; what is that between me and you? bury therefore your dead. And Abraham listened to Ephron; עֶפְרוֹן and Abraham weighed to Ephron עֶפְרוֹן the silver, which he had named in the audience of the sons of Heth, four hundred shekels of silver, current money with the merchant.

Genesis 24:3 And I will make you swear by the LORD, the God of heaven, and the God of the earth, that you shall not take a wife to my son of the daughters of the Canaanites, among whom I dwell:

Genesis 9:25 And he said, Cursed be Canaan; a servant of servants shall he be to his brothers.

Genesis 24:4-6 But you shall go to my country, and to my kindred, and take a wife to my son Isaac. And the servant said to him, Peradventure the woman will not be willing to follow me to this land: must I needs bring your son again to the land from from where you came? And Abraham said to him, Beware you that you bring not my son thither again.

Genesis 24:8 And if the woman will not be willing to follow you, then you shall be clear from this my oath: only bring not my son thither again.

Genesis 24:10-12 And the servant took ten camels of the camels of his master, and departed; for all the goods of his master were in his hand: and he arose, and went to Mesopotamia, to the city of Nahor. And he made his camels to kneel down without the city by a well of water at the time of the evening, even the time that women go out to draw water. And he said O LORD God of my master Abraham, I pray you, send me good speed this day, and show kindness to my master Abraham.

Genesis 24:17-20 And the servant ran to meet her, and said, Let me, I pray you, drink a little water of your pitcher. And she said, Drink, my lord: and she hurried, and let down her pitcher on her hand, and gave him drink. And when she had done giving him drink, she said, I will draw water for your camels also, until they have done drinking. And she hurried, and emptied her pitcher into the trough, and ran again to the well to draw water, and drew for all his camels.

Notes:

Genesis 24:22 And it came to pass, as the camels had done drinking, that the man took a golden earring of half a shekel בקע weight, and two bracelets for her hands of ten shekels weight of gold;

בקע Bekah; to cleave

One bekah = $\frac{1}{2}$ shekel

This word is only found twice in scripture.

Exodus 38:26 a beka בקע a head, גלגלת that is, half a shekel, after the shekel of the sanctuary, for everyone who passed over to those who were numbered, from twenty years old and upward, for six hundred three thousand five hundred fifty men. (HNV)

גלגלת gulgolet means a skull

Matthew 27:33 And when they were come unto a place called Golgotha, that is to say, a place of a skull,

גלגלת בקע or one "beka gulgolet" for the building of the sanctuary to accept the sacrifices could also be translated as one "who is broken at Golgotha!"

Genesis 24:47 And I asked her, and said, Whose daughter are you? And she said, the daughter of Bethuel, Nahor's son, whom Milchah bore to him: and I put the earring on her face, and the bracelets on her hands.

Genesis 24:58 And they called Rebekah, and said to her, Will you go with this man? And she said, I will go.

Genesis 24:60 And they blessed Rebekah, and said to her, You are our sister, be you the mother of thousands of millions, and let your seed possess the gate of those which hate them.

Matthew 16:18 I also tell you that you are Peter, and on this rock I will build my assembly, and the gates of Sheol will not prevail against it. (HNV)

1Corinthians 15:26 The last enemy that will be abolished is death.

Psalms 45:10,11 Listen, O daughter, and consider, and incline your ear; forget also your own people, and your father's house; So shall the king greatly desire your beauty: for he is your Lord; and worship you him.

Genesis 22:19 So Abraham returned to his young men, and they rose up and went together to Beersheba; and Abraham dwelled at Beersheba.

Genesis 24:64 And Rebekah lifted up her eyes, and when she saw Isaac, she lighted off the camel.

Genesis 25:17,18 And these are the years of the life of Ishmael, a hundred and thirty and seven years; and he expireth, and dieth, and is gathered unto his people; and they tabernacle from Havilah unto Shur, which is before Egypt, in thy going towards Asshur; in the presence of all his brethren hath he fallen.

Mark 1:1-3 The beginning of the Good News of Yeshua the Messiah, the Son of God. As it is written in the Prophets, "Behold, I send my messenger before your face, who will prepare your way before you. / The voice of one crying in the wilderness, 'Make ready the way of the Lord! Make his paths straight!'" (HNV)

Notes:

Matthew 11:1-3 It happened that when Yeshua had finished directing his twelve disciples, he departed from there to teach and proclaim in their cities. Now when Yochanan heard in the prison the works of Messiah, he sent two of his disciples and said to him, "Are you he who comes, or should we look for another?" (HNV)

Matthew 11:10 For this is he, of whom it is written, 'Behold, I send my messenger before your face, who will prepare your way before you.' (HNV)

Malachi 3:1 "Behold, I send my messenger, and he will prepare the way before me; and the Lord, whom you seek, will suddenly come to his temple; and the messenger of the covenant, whom you desire, **behold**, he comes!" says the LORD of Hosts.

John 1:29 The next day, he saw Yeshua coming to him, and said, "Behold, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world! (HNV)

Matthew 11:12 From the days of Yochanan the Immerser until now, the Kingdom of Heaven suffers violence, and the violent take it by force. (HNV)

Genesis 25:19-23 And these are the generations of Isaac, Abraham's son: Abraham begat Isaac: And Isaac was forty years old when he took Rebekah to wife, the daughter of Bethuel the Syrian of Padanaram, the sister to Laban the Syrian. And Isaac entreated the LORD for his wife, because she was barren: and the LORD was entreated of him, and Rebekah his wife conceived. And the children struggled together within her; and she said, If it be so, why am I thus? And she went to inquire of the LORD. And the LORD said to her, Two nations are in your womb, and two manner of people shall be separated from your bowels; and the one people shall be stronger than the other people; and the elder shall serve the younger.

Genesis 25:24-26 And when her days to be delivered were fulfilled, behold, there were twins in her womb. And the first came out red, all over like a hairy garment; and they called his name Esau. And after that came his brother out, and his hand took hold on Esau's heel; and his name was called Jacob: and Isaac was three score years old when she bore them.

Genesis 38:26-30 And Judah acknowledged them, and said, She has been more righteous than I; because that I gave her not to Shelah my son. And he knew her again no more. And it came to pass in the time of her travail, that, behold, twins were in her womb. And it came to pass, when she travailed, that the one put out his hand: and the midwife took and bound on his hand a scarlet thread, saying, This came out first. And it came to pass, as he drew back his hand, that, behold, his brother came out: and she said, How have you broken forth? this breach be on you: therefore his name was called Pharez. And afterward came out his brother, that had the scarlet thread on his hand: and his name was called Zarah.

Ruth 4:18 Now these are the generations of Pharez: Pharez begat Hezron,

Ruth 4:22 And Obed begat Jesse, and Jesse begat David.

Micah 2:12,13 I will surely assemble, O Jacob, all of you; I will surely gather the remnant of Israel; I will put them together as the sheep of **Bozrah**, as the flock in the middle of their fold: they shall make great noise by reason of the multitude of men. The breaker is come up before them: they have broken up, and have passed through the gate, and are gone out by it: and their king shall pass before them, and the LORD on the head of them.

Notes:

Matthew 11:28-30 Come to me, all you that labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke on you, and learn of me; for I am meek and lowly in heart: and you shall find rest to your souls. For my yoke is easy, and my burden is light.

Matthew 12:1,2 At that time Jesus went on the sabbath day through the corn; and his disciples were an hungered, and began to pluck the ears of corn and to eat. But when the Pharisees saw it, they said to him, Behold, your disciples do that which is not lawful to do on the sabbath day.

Matthew 12:8 For the Son of man is Lord even of the sabbath day.

Matthew 12:15-21 But when Jesus knew it, he withdrew himself from there: and great multitudes followed him, and he healed them all; And charged them that they should not make him known: That it might be fulfilled which was spoken by Esaias the prophet, saying Behold my servant, whom I have chosen; my beloved, in whom my soul is well pleased: I will put my spirit on him, and he shall show judgment to the Gentiles. He shall not strive, nor cry; neither shall any man hear his voice in the streets. A bruised reed shall he not break, and smoking flax shall he not quench, till he send forth judgment to victory. And in his name shall the Gentiles trust.

Isaiah 42:1-4 Behold my servant, whom I uphold; my elect, in whom my soul delights; I have put my spirit on him: he shall bring forth judgment to the Gentiles. He shall not cry, nor lift up, nor cause his voice to be heard in the street. A bruised reed shall he not break, and the smoking flax shall he not quench: he shall bring forth judgment to truth. He shall not fail nor be discouraged, till he have set judgment in the earth: and the isles shall wait for his law.

Exodus 8:19 Then the magicians said to Pharaoh, This is the finger of God: and Pharaoh's heart was hardened, and he listened not to them; as the LORD had said.

Exodus 31:18 And he gave to Moses, when he had made an end of communing with him on mount Sinai, two tables of testimony, tables of stone, written with the finger of God.

Luke 11:19-22 And if I by Beelzebub cast out devils, by whom do your sons cast them out? therefore shall they be your judges. But if I with the finger of God cast out devils, no doubt the kingdom of God is come on you. When a strong man armed keeps his palace, his goods are in peace: But when a stronger than he shall come on him, and overcome him, he takes from him all his armor wherein he trusted, and divides his spoils.

Matthew 12:22-28 Then was brought to him one possessed with a devil, blind, and dumb: and he healed him, so that the blind and dumb both spoke and saw. And all the people were amazed, and said, Is not this the son of David? But when the Pharisees heard it, they said, This fellow does not cast out devils, but by Beelzebub the prince of the devils. And Jesus knew their thoughts, and said to them, Every kingdom divided against itself is brought to desolation; and every city or house divided against itself shall not stand: And if Satan cast out Satan, he is divided against himself; how shall then his kingdom stand? And if I by Beelzebub cast out devils, by whom do your children cast them out? therefore they shall be your judges. But if I cast out devils by the Spirit of God, then the kingdom of God is come to you.
