(AKJV) **Genesis 4:25,26** And Adam knew his wife again; and she bore a son, and called his name **Seth**: For God, said she, has **appointed** me another seed instead of Abel, whom Cain slew. And to Seth, to him also there was born a son; and he called his name Enos: then **began men to call on the name of the LORD.**

(KJV) **Isaiah 42:5-8** Thus saith God the Lord, he that created the heavens, and stretched them out; he that spread forth the earth, and that which cometh out of it; he that giveth breath unto the people upon it, and spirit to them that walk therein: I the Lord have called thee in righteousness, and will hold thine hand, and will keep thee, and give thee for a covenant of the people, for a light of the Gentiles; To open the blind eyes, to bring out the prisoners from the prison, and them that sit in darkness out of the prison house. I am the Lord: that is my name: and my glory will I not give to another, neither my praise to graven images.

(KJV) **Isaiah 42:21-23** The Lord is well pleased for his righteousness 'sake; he will magnify the law, and make it honourable. But this is a people robbed and spoiled; they are all of them snared in holes, and they are hid in prison houses: they are for a prey, and none delivereth; for a spoil, and none saith, **Restore.** Who among you will give ear to this? who will hearken and hear for the time to come?

(KJV) **Isaiah 42:24,25** Who gave Jacob for a spoil, and Israel to the robbers? did not the Lord, he against whom we have sinned? for they would not walk in his ways, neither were they obedient unto his law. Therefore he hath poured upon him the fury of his anger, and the strength of battle: and it hath set him on fire round about, yet he knew not; and it burned him, yet he laid it not to heart.

(KJV) **Isaiah 43:1** But now thus saith the Lord that created thee, O Jacob, and he that formed thee, O Israel, Fear not: for I have redeemed thee, I have called thee by thy name; thou art mine.

(KJV) **Isaiah 43:5-7** Fear not: for I am with thee: I will bring thy seed from the east, and gather thee from the west; I will say to the north, Give up; and to the south, Keep not back: bring my sons from far, and my daughters from the ends of the earth; Even every one that is called by my name: for I have created him for my glory, I have formed him; yea, I have made him.

(KJV) **Isaiah 43:10,11** Ye are my witnesses, saith the Lord, and my servant whom I have chosen: that ye may know and believe me, and understand that I am he: before me there was no God formed, neither shall there be after me. I, even I, am the Lord; and beside me there is no savior.

(AKJV) **Genesis 2:4** These are the **generations** of the heavens and of the earth when they were created, in the day that the LORD God made the earth and the heavens,

(AKJV) **Genesis 5:1a** This is the book of the **generations** of Adam.

(AKJV) **Ruth 4:18** Now these are the **generations** of Pharez: Pharez begat Hezron,

(AKJV) **Ruth 4:21,22** And Salmon begat Boaz, and Boaz begat Obed, And Obed begat Jesse, and Jesse begat **David**.

(HNV) **Matthew 1:1** A record of the genealogy of Yeshua the Messiah, the **son of David**, the son of Abraham.

(HNV) **Matthew 1:16,17** Jacob became the father of Joseph, the husband of Miriam, from whom was born Yeshua, who is called Messiah. So all the generations from Abraham to David are fourteen generations; from David to the exile to Babylon fourteen generations; and from the carrying away to Babylon to the Messiah, fourteen generations.

(HNV) **Matthew 1:21-23** She shall bring forth a son. You shall call his name Yeshua, for it is he who shall save his people from their sins.” Now all this has happened, that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by the Lord through the prophet, saying, “Behold, the virgin shall be with child, and shall bring forth a son. They shall call his name Immanuel;” which is, being interpreted, “God with us.”

Notes:

(HNV) **Matthew 2:1-3** Now when Yeshua was born in Bethlehem of Judea in the days of King Herod, behold, wise men from the east came to Jerusalem, saying, “Where is he who is born King of the Jews? For we saw his star in the east, and have come to worship him.” When King Herod heard it, he was troubled, and all Jerusalem with him.

(HNV) **Matthew 2:5,6** They said to him, “In Bethlehem of Judea, for this is written through the prophet, ‘You Bethlehem, land of Judah, are in no way least among the princes of Judah: for out of you shall come forth a governor, who shall shepherd my people, Israel.’”

(HNV) **Matthew 2:14,15** He arose and took the young child and his mother by night, and departed into Egypt, and was there until the death of Herod; that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by the Lord through the prophet, saying, “Out of Egypt I called my son.”

(HNV) **Matthew 2:16,17** Then Herod, when he saw that he was mocked by the wise men, was exceedingly angry, and sent out, and killed all the male children who were in Bethlehem and in all the surrounding countryside, from two years old and under, according to the exact time which he had learned from the wise men. Then that which was spoken by Jeremiah the prophet was fulfilled, saying,

(HNV) **Matthew 2:23** And he came and lived in a city called Nazareth: that it might be fulfilled which was spoken through the prophets, He will be called a Nazarene

(AKJV) **Genesis 1:1** In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth.

(HNV) **Colossians 1:16-18** For by him all things were created, in the heavens, and on the earth, things visible and invisible, whether thrones, or dominions, or principalities, or powers: all things have been created through him, and for him: He is before all things, and by him all things consist. He is the head of the body, the assembly: who is the beginning, (Reisheet!) the firstborn from the dead; that in all things he might have the preeminence.

(AKJV) **John 1:1-3** In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. The same was in the beginning with God. All things were made by him; and without him was not any thing made that was made.

(AKJV) **Psalms 33:6** By the Word of the LORD were the heavens made; and all the host of them by the breath of his mouth.

(AKJV) **Philippians 2:8** And being found in fashion as a man, he humbled himself, and became obedient to death, even the death of the cross.

(AKJV) **Psalms 22:6** But I am a worm, and no man; a reproach of men, and despised of the people.

(AKJV) **Isaiah 41:14** Fear not, you worm Jacob, and you men of Israel; I will help you, said the LORD, and your redeemer, the Holy One of Israel.

Notes:

(AKJV) **Psalms 119:128a** Therefore I esteem all thy precepts concerning all things to be **right**.

(AKJV) **Proverbs 15:19** The way of the slothful man is as an hedge of thorns: but the way of the **righteous** is made plain.

(AKJV) **Isaiah 40:3** The voice of him that cries in the wilderness, Prepare you the way of the LORD, make **straight** in the desert a highway for our God.

(AKJV) **Genesis 2:7,8** And the LORD God **formed** man of the dust of the ground, and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life; and man became a living soul. And the LORD God **planted a garden** eastward in Eden; and **there he put the man whom he had formed**.

(HNV) **John 20:15a** Yeshua said to her, “Woman, why are you weeping? Who are you looking for?” She, supposing him to be **the gardener**,

(AKJV) **Genesis 2:16,17** And the LORD God commanded **the man**, saying, Of every tree of the garden **you** may freely eat: But of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, **you** shall not eat of it: for in the day that **you** eat thereof **you** shall surely die.

(AKJV) **Genesis 2:18-20** And the LORD God said, **It is not good that the man should be alone**: I will make him an **help meet** for him. And out of the ground the LORD God **formed every beast** of the field, and every fowl of the air; and brought them to Adam to see what he would call them: and whatever Adam called every living creature, that was the name thereof. And Adam gave names to all cattle, and to the fowl of the air, and to every beast of the field; but for Adam there was not found **an help meet for him**.

(AKJV) **Genesis 3:23,24** Therefore the LORD God sent **him** forth **from the garden** of Eden, **to till the ground from where he was taken**. So he drove out **the man**; and he placed at the east of the garden of Eden **Cherubim, and a flaming sword** which turned every way, to keep **the Way of the tree of life**.

(AKJV) **Exodus 26:31** And you shall make a veil of blue, and purple, and scarlet, and fine twined linen of cunning work: with cherubim shall it be made:

(HNV) **Revelation 22:13,14** I am the Alef and the Tav, the First and the Last, the Beginning and the End. Blessed are those who do his commandments, that they may have the **right to the tree of life**, and may enter in by the gates into the city.

(HNV) **John 14:6** Yeshua said to him, “I am **the Way**, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father, except through me.

Notes:

(HNV) **Acts 24:14** But this I confess to you, that after **the Way**, which they call a sect, so I serve the God of our fathers, believing all things which are according to the Torah, and which are written in the Prophets;

(AKJV) **John 4:22** You worship you know not what: we know what we worship: for **salvation is of the Jews**.

(HNV) **Revelation 1:12,13** I turned to see the voice that spoke with me. Having turned, I saw seven golden menorahs. And among the menorahs was one like a son of man, clothed with a robe reaching down to his feet, and with a golden sash around his chest.

(AKJV) **Zechariah 12:10** And I will pour on the house of David, and on the inhabitants of Jerusalem, the spirit of grace and of supplications: and they shall look on me whom **they have pierced**, and they shall mourn for him, as one mourns for his only son, and shall be in bitterness for him, as one that is in bitterness for his firstborn.

(AKJV) **Psalms 119:130** The entrance of your **Words gives light**; it gives understanding to the simple.

(AKJV) **Genesis 1:3,4** And God said, Let there be light: and there was light. And God saw **the light**, that **it was good**: and God divided the light from the darkness.
Aleph Tav the light!!!

(AKJV) **1Timothy 1:8a** But we know that **the law is good**,

(AKJV) **Proverbs 6:23** For the commandment is a lamp; and **the law is light**; and reproofs of instruction are **the way** of life:

It has been a long standing tradition at El Shaddai Ministries to fellowship together after the service every 2nd Saturday by **sharing a meal**. El Shaddai Ministries provides all the beverages for the break and oneg. Please do **not** add items to the table.

If you are blessed to be able to bring a dish for oneg, please observe the following guidelines:

- All items must be checked in with the oneg staff. Items **not checked in will not be served**.
- All items must be marked with your name and phone number.
- Only bring “Biblically clean” foods, i.e. **NO pork, shellfish, or gelatin products**.
- Please bring fresh cooked dishes and not leftovers.
- Packaged food must be unopened.
- Also after ONEG **make sure to take your dishes and utensils home**.

If there is any question as to these standards please discuss with the Zakens after the service.

We ask that you let seniors; first time visitors and those with mobility issues go first in line. Parents of small children please help your child with their plates. Also **PLEASE be courteous** in the ONEG line and be observant of those around you, so others may get a generous helping of food as well.
