Vayakhel - (He assembled)

(NKJV) **Exodus 35:1-2** Then Moses gathered all the congregation of the children of Israel together, and said to them, "These *are* the words which the LORD has commanded *you* to do: "Work shall be done for six days, but the seventh day shall be a holy day for you, a Sabbath of rest to the LORD. Whoever does any work on it shall be put to death.

(NKJV) **Exodus 33:15** Then he said to Him, "If Your Presence does not go *with us*, do not bring us up from here.

(NKJV) **Exodus 35:5** Take from among you an offering for Adonai whoever has a willing heart, let him bring Adonai's offering; gold, silver and bronze;

(ASV) **Exodus 35:10** And let every wise-hearted man among you come, and make all that Jehovah hath commanded:

(TLV) **Exodus 35:21** Everyone whose heart stirred him and everyone whose spirit was willing came and brought Adonai's offering for the work of the Tent of Meeting and for all it's service as well as for the holy garments.

(TLV) **Exodus 35:25** - Also all the women who were wise-hearted spun with their hands, and brought what they had woven- the blue, purple, scarlet and fine linen.

(TLV) **Exodus 36:1** So Bezalel and Oholiab are to work along with every - wisehearted man in whom Adonai has placed insight and understanding to his to perform all the labor for service of the Sanctuary, according to everything Adonai has commanded.

(Vine of David) **Matthew 7:24-27** So anyone who hears these words of mine and does them, I will compare to a wise man who built his house on a rock. The rain fell, the streams flooded, the winds blew, and they touched that house, but it did not fall, because it was founded upon the rock. But whoever hears these words of mine but does not do them, I will compare to a foolish man who built his house upon the sand. The rain fell, the streams flooded the winds blew and they encountered that house. It fell, and its collapse was great.....

Pekudei - (Accounts)

(NKJV) **Exodus 38:22** Bezalel the son of Uri, the son of Hur, of the tribe of Judah, made all that the LORD had commanded Moses.

(NKJV) **Exodus 39:1** Of the blue, purple, and scarlet *thread* they made garments of ministry, for ministering in the holy *place*, and made the holy garments for Aaron, as the LORD had commanded Moses.

(NKJV) **Exodus 39:5** And the intricately woven band of his ephod that *was* on it *was* of the same workmanship, *woven of gold, blue, purple, and scarlet thread, and of fine woven linen*, as the LORD had commanded Moses.

(NKJV) **Exodus 39:32** Thus all the work of the tabernacle of the tent of meeting was finished. And the children of Israel did according to all that the LORD had commanded Moses; so they did.

(NKJV) **Exodus 39:42-43** According to all that the LORD had commanded Moses, so the children of Israel did all the work. Then Moses looked over all the work, and indeed they had done it; as the LORD had commanded, just so they had done it. And Moses blessed them.

(NKJV) **Psalms 90:17** - And let the beauty of the LORD our God be upon us, And establish the work of our hands for us; Yes, establish the work of our hands.

(NKJV) **Exodus 40:1** "On the first day of the first month you shall set up the tabernacle of the tent of meeting.

(NKJV) **Exodus 40:32** Whenever they went into the tabernacle of meeting, and when they came near the altar, they washed, as the LORD had commanded Moses.

(NKJV) **Psalms 24:4-5** He who has clean hands and a pure heart, Who has not lifted up his soul to an idol, Nor sworn deceitfully. He shall receive blessing from the LORD, And righteousness from the God of his salvation.

Notes:

(NKJV) **Romans 14:12** So then each of us shall give account of himself to God.

(NKJV) **Acts 13:22-23** - “And when He had removed him, He raised up for them David as king, to whom also He gave testimony and said, *‘I have found David the son of Jesse, a man after My own heart, who will do all My will. ‘From this man’s seed, according to the promise, God raised up for Israel a Savior— Yeshua..*

(NKJV) **John 12:49-50** - “For I have not spoken on **My own authority**; but the **Father** who sent Me gave Me a command, **what** I should say and **what** I should speak. “And I know that His command is everlasting life. Therefore, whatever I speak, just as the Father has told Me, so I speak.”

(NKJV) **John 14:6** Yeshua said to him, “I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me.

(NKJV) **John 14:15** - If you love Me, **keep My commandments**.

(NKJV) **John 15:10** “If you **keep My commandments**, you will abide in **My** love, just as I have kept **My** Father's **commandments** and abide in His love.

(NKJV) **Exodus 40:34-38** Then the cloud covered the tabernacle of meeting, and the glory of the LORD filled the tabernacle. And Moses was not able to enter the tabernacle of meeting, because the cloud rested above it, and the glory of the LORD filled the tabernacle. Whenever the cloud was taken up from above the tabernacle, the children of Israel would go onward in all their journeys. But if the cloud was not taken up, then they did not journey till the day that it was taken up. For the cloud of the LORD was above the tabernacle by day, and fire was over it by night, in the sight of all the house of Israel, throughout all their journeys.

(NASB) **I Corinthians 3:16-17** Do you know that you are a temple of God and that the Spirit of God dwells in you? If any man destroys the temple of God, God will destroy him, for the temple of God is holy, **and that is what you are.**

(NKJV) **Isaiah 43:7** Everyone who is called by My name, Whom I have created for My glory; I have formed him, yes, I have made him.”

It's not what you did... IT'S WHAT YOU DIDN'T DO!

Revelation 18:4 And I heard another voice from heaven, saying, Come out of her [Babylon], my people, that ye be not partakers of her sins, and that ye receive not of her plagues.

Hosea 4:6 My people are destroyed for lack of knowledge: because thou hast rejected knowledge, I wall also reject thee, that thou shalt be no priest to me: seeing thou hast forgotten the law of thy God, I wall also forget thy children.

Notes:

Matthew 7:21-23 Not even- one that saith unto me. Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that doeth the will of my Father which is in heaven. Many will say to me in that day. Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in thy name? and in thy name have cast out devils? and in thy name done man)' wonderful works? And then will I profess unto them. I never knew you: depart from me, ye that work iniquity.

Psalms 6:8 Depart from me, all ye workers of lawlessness: for the LORD hath heard the voice of my weeping.

So what is the definition of lawlessness or iniquity? 1 John 3:4 says that sin (iniquity) is the transgression of the Torah laws.

Romans 2:12-13 For as many as have sinned without law (Torah) shall also perish without law: and as many as have sinned in the law shall be judged by the law; (For not the hearers of the law are just before God, but the doers of the law shall be justified.

2 Timothy 3:16 All scripture *is* given by inspiration of God, and *is* profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness:

2 Timothy 4:2-3 Preach the word; be instant in season, out of season; reprove, rebuke, exhort with all longsuffering and doctrine. For the time will come when they will not endure sound doctrine: but after their own lusts shall they heap to themselves teachers, having itching ears;

John 3:21 But he that doeth truth cometh to the light, that his deeds may be made manifest, that they are wrought in God.

WHAT IS TRUTH?

John 17:6 I have manifested thy name unto the men which thou gavest me out of the world: thine they were, and thou gavest them me; and they have kept thy word.

John 17:17 Sanctify them through thy truth: thy word is truth.

John 17:19 And for their sakes I sanctify myself, that they also might be sanctified through the truth.

Malachi 3:6 For I *am* the LORD, I change not; therefore ye sons of Jacob are not consumed.

Joshua 24:14 Now therefore fear the LORD, and serve him in sincerity and in truth: and put away the gods which your fathers served on the other side of the flood, and in Egypt; and serve ye the LORD.

Notes:

Joshua 24:15 And if it seem evil unto you to serve the LORD, choose you this day whom ye will serve; whether the gods which your fathers served that *were* on the other side of the flood, or the gods of the Amorites, in whose land ye dwell: but as for me and my house, we will serve the LORD.

Deuteronomy 4:6 Keep therefore and do them; for this *is* your wisdom and your understanding in the sight of the nations, which shall hear all these statutes, and say, Surely this great nation *is* a wise and understanding people.

Deuteronomy 5:1 And Moses called all Israel, and said unto them, Hear, O Israel, the statutes and judgments which I speak in your ears this day, that ye may learn them, and keep, and do them.

Deuteronomy 30:12-14 It *is* not in heaven, that thou shouldest say, Who shall go up for us to heaven, and bring it unto us, that we may hear it, and do it? Neither *is* it beyond the sea, that thou shouldest say, Who shall go over the sea for us, and bring it unto us, that we may hear it, and do it? But the word *is* very nigh unto thee, in thy mouth, and in thy heart, that thou mayest do it.

Exodus 16:4 Then said the LORD unto Moses, Behold, I will rain bread from heaven for you; and the people shall go out and gather a certain rate every day, that I may prove them, whether they will walk in my law, or not.

Deuteronomy 31:12 Gather the people together, men, and women, and children, and thy stranger that *is* within thy gates, that they may hear, and that they may learn, and fear the LORD your God, and observe to do all the words of this law:

Deuteronomy 30:10 If thou shalt hearken unto the voice of the LORD thy God, to keep his commandments and his statutes which are written in this book of the law, *and* if thou turn unto the LORD thy God with all thine heart, and with all thy soul.

Deuteronomy 30:16 In that I command thee this day to love the LORD thy God, to walk in his ways, and to keep his commandments and his statutes and his judgments, that thou mayest live and multiply: and the LORD thy God shall bless thee in the land whither thou goest to possess it.

Deuteronomy 6:25 And it shall be our righteousness, if we observe to do all these commandments before the LORD our God, as he hath commanded us.

Exodus 20:6 And shewing mercy unto thousands of them that love me, and keep my commandments.

1 John 2:4-6 He that saith, I know him, and keepeth not his commandments, is a liar, and the truth is not in him. But whoso keepeth his word, in him verily is the love of God perfected: hereby know we that we are in him. He that saith he abideth in him ought himself also so to walk, even as he walked, (he followed the torah)

Notes:

John 12:49-50 For I have not spoken of myself; but the Father which sent me, he gave me a commandment, what I should say, and what I should speak. And I know that his commandment is life everlasting: whatsoever I speak therefore, even as the Father said unto me,

John 14:9-10 Jesus saith unto him, Have I been so long time with you, and yet hast thou not known me, Philip? he that hath seen me hath seen the Father: and how sayest thou *then*, Shew us the Father? Believest thou not that I am in the Father, and the Father in me? The words that I speak unto you I speak not of myself: but the Father that dwelleth in me, he doeth the works.

John 15:9-10 As the Father hath loved me, so have I loved you: continue ye in my love. If ye keep my commandments, ye shall abide in my love; even as I have kept my Father's commandments, and abide in his love.

John 14:15 If ye love me, keep my commandments.

1 John 5:3 For this is the love of God, that we keep his commandments: and his commandments are not grievous.

1 Samuel 15:22 And Samuel said, Hath the LORD *as great* delight in burnt offerings and sacrifices, as in obeying the voice of the LORD? Behold, to obey is better than sacrifice, and to hearken than the fat of rams. So what is the definition of God's people in the last days?

Revelation 12:17 And the dragon was wroth with the woman, and went to make war with the remnant of her seed, which keep the commandments of God, and have the testimony of Jesus Christ.

Revelation 14:12 Here is the patience of the saints: here *are* they that keep the commandments of God, and the faith of Jesus.

Revelation 22:12 And, behold, I come quickly; and my reward is with me, to give every man according to his works.

God is looking at if we truly love Him by keeping His commandments when Messiah returns!

1 John 2:24 Let that therefore abide (*the word abide comes from G3306# is a primary verb to do*) in you, which ye have heard from the beginning. If that which ye have heard from the beginning shall remain in you, ye also shall continue in the Son, and in the Father.

Luke 11:28 But he said, Yea rather, blessed *are* they that hear the word of God, and keep it.

Acts 5:27-29 And when they had brought them, they set *them* before the council: and the high priest asked them, Saying, Did not we straightly command you that ye should not teach in this name? and, behold, ye have filled Jerusalem with your doctrine, and intend to bring this man's blood upon us. Then Peter and the *other* apostles answered and said, We ought to obey God rather than men.

Notes:

Hebrews 5:9 And being made perfect, he became the author of eternal salvation unto all them that obey him;

1 Peter 1:25 But the word of the Lord endureth forever. And this is the word which by the gospel is preached unto you.

Proverbs 16:25 There is a way that seemeth right unto a man, but the end thereof *are* the ways of death.

Jeremiah 9:6 Thine habitation *is* in the midst of deceit; through deceit they refuse to know me, saith the LORD.

So what are some examples of things the Lord God asks us to do?

Numbers 15:38 Speak unto the children of Israel, and bid them that they make them fringes in the borders of their garments throughout their generations, and that they put upon the fringe of the borders a cord of blue:

Deuteronomy 8:10 When thou hast eaten and art full, then thou shalt bless the LORD thy God for the good land which he hath given thee.

Deuteronomy 6:7 And thou shalt teach them diligently unto thy children, and shalt talk of them when thou sittest in thine house, and when thou walkest by the way, and when thou liest down, and when thou risest up.

Luke 24:13 And, behold, two of them went that same day to a village called Emmaus, which was from Jerusalem *about* threescore furlongs.

Luke 24:14-17 And they talked together of all these things which had happened. And it came to pass, that, while they communed *together* and reasoned, Jesus himself drew near, and went with them. But their eyes were holden that they should not know him. And he said unto them, What manner of communications *are* these that ye have one to another, as ye walk, and are sad.

Exodus 20:8-10 Remember the sabbath day, to keep it holy. Six days shalt thou labour, and do all thy work: But the seventh day is the sabbath of the LORD thy God: in it thou shalt not do any work...

Exodus 31:13 Speak thou also unto the children of Israel, saying, Verily my sabbaths ye shall keep: for it *is* a sign between me and you throughout your generations; that ye may know that I *am* the LORD that doth sanctify you.

Leviticus 23:2 Speak unto the children of Israel, and say unto them, *Concerning* the feasts of the LORD, which ye shall proclaim *to be* holy convocations, *even* these *are* my feasts.

Revelations 22:14 Blessed *are* they that do his commandments, that they may have right to the tree of life, and may enter in through the gates into the city.

In order to bless and protect our congregation, we have put some guidelines in place and ask those attending to observe these to the best of their ability.

It has been a long standing tradition at El Shaddai Ministries to fellowship together after the service every 2nd Saturday by **sharing a meal**. El Shaddai Ministries provides all the beverages for the break and oneg. Please do **not** add items to the table.

If you are blessed to be able to bring a dish for oneg, please observe the following guidelines:

- All items must be checked in with the oneg staff. Items **not checked in will not be served**.
- All items must be marked with your name and phone number.
- Only bring "Biblically clean" foods, i.e. **NO pork, shellfish, or gelatin products**.
- Please bring fresh cooked dishes and not leftovers.
- Packaged food must be unopened.
- Also after ONEG **make sure to take your dishes and utensils home**.

If there is any question as to these standards please discuss with the Zakens after the service.

We ask that you let seniors; first time visitors and those with mobility issues go first in line. Parents of small children please help your child with their plates. Also **PLEASE be courteous** in the ONEG line and be observant of those around you, so others may get a generous helping of food as well.
