Colossians 1:16-18 For by him were all things created, that are in heaven, and that are in earth, visible and invisible, whether they be thrones, or dominions, or principalities, or powers: all things were created by him, and for him: And he is before all things, and by him all things consist. And he is the head of the body, the church: who is the beginning, (Reisheet!) the firstborn from the dead; that in all things he might have the preeminence.

1Timothy 1:8 But we know that the law is good,

Proverbs 6:23 For the commandment is a lamp; and the law is light; and reproofs of instruction are the way of life:

Isaiah 8:20 To the law and to the testimony: if they speak not according to this word, it is because there is no light in them.

Revelation 12:17 And the dragon was wroth with the woman, and went to make war with the remnant of her seed, which keep the commandments of God, and have the testimony of Yeshua HaMashiach.

John 3:19-21 And this is the condemnation, that light is come into the world, and men loved darkness rather than light, because their deeds were evil. For every one that doeth evil hateth the light, neither cometh to the light, lest his deeds should be reproved. But he that doeth truth cometh to the light, that his deeds may be made manifest, that they are wrought in God.

Let there be light

Light has come into the world

There was light

Men loved darkness more than light

God saw the light - it was good

Those who are wicked hate the light

God separated the light from darkness

They do not come to the light

God called the light Day

Those who love truth come to the light

Genesis 3:23,24 Therefore the LORD God sent him forth from the garden of Eden, to till the ground from whence he was taken. So he drove out the man; and he placed at the east of the garden of Eden Cherubims, and a flaming sword which turned every way, to keep the way of the tree of life.

Disobedience by both Adam and Eve was the problem.

Exodus 26:31 And thou shalt make a vail of blue, and purple, and scarlet, and fine twined linen of cunning work: with cherubims shall it be made:

Leviticus 16:2 "Tell your brother Aaron that he shall not enter at any time into the holy place inside the veil, before the mercy seat which is on the ark, or he will die..."

Notes:

Revelation 22:13,14 I am Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the end, the first and the last. Blessed are they that **do his commandments, that they may have right to the tree of life**, and may enter in through the gates into the city.

John 14:6 Yeshua said to him, "I am the way, the truth, and the life.

Acts 24:14 But this I confess unto thee, that after **the way** which they call heresy, so worship I the God of my fathers, believing all things which are written in the law and in the prophets:

Genesis 2:7,8 And the LORD God formed **אָדָם** man of the dust of the ground, and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life; and man became a living soul. And the LORD God **planted a garden** eastward in Eden; and **there he put the man whom he had formed**.

John 20:15a Yeshua said to her, "Woman, why are you weeping? Who are you looking for?" She, supposing him to be **the gardener**,

Genesis 2:16,17 And the LORD God commanded **the man**, saying, Of every tree of the garden **you** may freely eat: But of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, **you** shall not eat of it: for in the day that **you** eat thereof **you** shall surely die.

Eve did not hear the command

Genesis 2:18-20 And the LORD God said, It is not good that the man should be alone; I will make him an help meet for him. And out of the ground the LORD God formed **בְּהֵמָה** every beast of the field, and every fowl of the air; and brought them to Adam to see what he would call them: and whatever Adam called every living creature, that was the name thereof. And Adam gave names to all cattle, and to the fowl of the air, and to every beast of the field; but for Adam there was not found **an help meet for him**.

Psalms 24:1,2 The earth is the Lord's, and the fullness thereof; the world, and they that dwell therein. For he hath founded it upon the seas, and established it upon the floods.

Deuteronomy 32:8 When the most High divided to the nations their inheritance, when he separated the sons of Adam, he set the bounds of the people according to the number of the children of Israel

Leviticus 18:25 And the land is defiled: therefore I do visit the iniquity thereof upon it, and the land itself vomiteth out her inhabitants.

Notes:

Leviticus 18:27,28 (For all these abominations have the men of the land done, which were before you, and the land is defiled;) That the land spue not you out also, when ye defile it, as it spued out the nations that were before you. Then He expelled Israel from the Land for their disobedience.

Genesis 2:7 And the Lord God formed man of the dust of the ground, and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life; and man became a living soul.

Isaiah 42:5-8 Thus saith God the Lord, he that created the heavens, and stretched them out; he that spread forth the earth, and that which cometh out of it; he that giveth breath unto the people upon it, and spirit to them that walk therein: I the Lord have called thee in righteousness, and will hold thine hand, and will keep thee, and give thee for a covenant of the people, for a light of the Gentiles; To open the blind eyes, to bring out the prisoners from the prison, and them that sit in darkness out of the prison house. I am the Lord: that is my name: and my glory will I not give to another, neither my praise to graven images.

Isaiah 42:21-23 The Lord is well pleased for his righteousness 'sake; he will magnify the law, and make it honourable. But this is a people robbed and spoiled; they are all of them snared in holes, and they are hid in prison houses: they are for a prey, and none delivereth; for a spoil, and none saith, **Restore**. Who among you will give ear to this? who will hearken and hear for the time to come?

Acts 3:19-21 "Repent therefore, and turn again, that your sins may be blotted out, so that there may come times of refreshing from the presence of the Lord, and that he may send Messiah Yeshua, who was ordained for you before, whom heaven must receive until the times of restoration of all things, which God spoke long ago by the mouth of his holy prophets.

Isaiah 42:24 Who gave Jacob for a spoil, and Israel to the robbers? did not the Lord, he against whom we have sinned? for they would not walk in his ways, neither were they obedient unto his law.

Isaiah 43:1 But now thus saith the Lord that created thee, O Jacob, and he that formed thee, O Israel, Fear not: for I have redeemed thee, I have called thee by thy name; thou art mine.

Isaiah 43:5-7 Fear not: for I am with thee: I will bring thy seed from the east, and gather thee from the west; I will say to the north, Give up; and to the south, Keep not back: bring my sons from far, and my daughters from the ends of the earth; Even every one that is called by my name: for I have created him for my glory, I have formed him; yea, I have made him.

Isaiah 43:10,11 Ye are my witnesses, saith the Lord, and my servant whom I have chosen: that ye may know and believe me, and understand that I am he: before me there was no God formed, neither shall there be after me. I, even I, am the LORD; and beside me there is no Messiah.

Notes:

Psalms 119:126-128 It is time for thee, LORD, to work: for they have made void Your Torah. Therefore I love your commandments above gold; yea, above fine gold. Therefore I esteem all your precepts concerning all things to be right; and I hate every false way.

Psalms 119:129-131 PE Your testimonies are wonderful: therefore does my soul keep them. The entrance of your words give light; it gives understanding unto the simple. I opened my mouth, and panted: for I longed for your commandments.

Isaiah 51:4-8 Hearken unto me, my people; and give ear unto me, O my nation: for a law shall proceed from me, and I will make my judgment to rest for a light of the people. My righteousness is near; my salvation is gone forth, and mine arms shall judge the people; the isles shall wait upon me, and on mine arm shall they trust. Lift up your eyes to the heavens, and look upon the earth beneath: for the heavens shall vanish away like smoke, and the earth shall wax old like a garment, and they that dwell therein shall die in like manner: but my salvation shall be forever, and my righteousness shall not be abolished. Hearken unto me, ye that know righteousness, the people in whose heart is my law; fear ye not the reproach of men, neither be ye afraid of their revilings. For the moth shall eat them up like a garment, and the worm shall eat them like wool: but my righteousness shall be for ever, and my salvation from generation to generation.

Genesis 4:25,26 And Adam knew his wife again; and she bore a son, and called his name Seth: For God, said she, has appointed me another seed instead of Abel, whom Cain slew. And to Seth, to him also there was born a son; and he called his name Enos: then began men to call on the name of the LORD.

Genesis 2:4 These are the generations תולדות of the heavens and of the earth when they were created, in the day that the LORD God made the earth and the heavens,

Genesis 5:1a This is the book of the generations תולדת of Adam.

Ruth 4:18 Now these are the generations תולדות of Pharez: Pharez begat Hezron,

Ruth 4:21,22 And Salmon begat Boaz, and Boaz begat Obed, And Obed begat Jesse, and Jesse begat David.

Matthew 1:1 A record of the genealogy of Yeshua the Messiah, the son of David, the son of Abraham.

Notes:

Matthew 1;16,17 Jacob became the father of Joseph, the husband of Miriam, from whom was born Yeshua, who is called Messiah. So all the generations from Abraham to David are fourteen generations; from David to the exile to Babylon fourteen generations; and from the carrying away to Babylon to the Messiah, fourteen generations.

Revelation 1:12,13 I turned to see the voice that spoke with me. Having turned, I saw seven golden menorahs. And among the menorahs was one like a son of man, clothed with a robe reaching down to his feet, and with a golden sash around his chest.

John 7:2 Now the Jews 'feast of tabernacles was at hand

John 7:37,38 Now on the last and greatest day of the feast, Yeshua stood and cried out, "If anyone is thirsty, let him come to me and drink! He who believes in me, as the Scripture has said, from within him will flow rivers of living water."

John 8:1,2 Yeshua went to the Mount of Olives. Now very early in the morning, he came again into the temple, and all the people came to him. He sat down, and taught them.

John 8:12 Again, therefore, Yeshua spoke to them, saying, "I am the light of the world. He who follows me will not walk in the darkness, but will have the light of life."

Zechariah 12:10 And I will pour on the house of David, and on the inhabitants of Jerusalem, the spirit of grace and of supplications: and they shall look on me whom they have pierced, and they shall mourn for him, as one mourns for his only son, and shall be in bitterness for him, as one that is in bitterness for his firstborn.

If you are blessed to be able to bring a dish for oneg, please observe the following guidelines:

- All items must be checked in with the oneg staff. Items **not checked in will not be served**.
- All items must be marked with your name and phone number.
- Only bring “Biblically clean” foods, i.e. **NO pork, shellfish, or gelatin products**.
- Please bring fresh cooked dishes and not leftovers.
- Packaged food must be unopened.
- Also after ONEG **make sure to take your dishes and utensils home**.

If there is any question as to these standards please discuss with the Zakens after the service.

We ask that you let seniors; first time visitors and those with mobility issues go first in line. Parents of small children please help your child with their plates.
