Genesis 6:22 Thus did Noah; according to all that God commanded him, so did he.

Isaiah 54:9-11 For this is as the waters of Noah unto me: for as I have sworn that the waters of Noah should no more go over the earth; so have I sworn that I would not be wroth with thee, nor rebuke thee. For the mountains shall depart, and the hills be removed; but my kindness shall not depart from thee, neither shall the covenant of my peace be removed, saith the Lord that hath mercy on thee.

Ezekiel 36:22-24 Therefore say unto the house of Israel, Thus saith the Lord God; I do not this for your sakes, O house of Israel, but for mine holy name's sake, which ye have profaned among the heathen, whither ye went. And I will sanctify my great name, which was profaned among the heathen, which ye have profaned in the midst of them; and the heathen shall know that I am the Lord, saith the Lord God, when I shall be sanctified in you before their eyes. For I will take you from among the heathen, and gather you out of all countries, and will bring you into your own land.

Exodus 6:7,8 And **I will** take you to me for a people, and **I will** be to you a God: and ye shall know that **I am** the Lord your God, which brings you out from under the burdens of the Egyptians. And I will bring you into the land, concerning which **I did swear to give it** - to Abraham, to Isaac, and to Jacob; and **I will give it you** for an heritage: I am the Lord.

Psalms 105:8-11 He has remembered his covenant forever, the word which he commanded to **one thousand generations**. Which covenant he made with Abraham, and his oath unto Isaac; And confirmed the same to Jacob for a law, and to Israel for an everlasting covenant: Saying, to you will I give the land of Canaan, the lot of your inheritance.

Psalms 83:4 O God, do not keep silence; do not hold your peace or be still, O God! For behold, **your** enemies make an uproar; those who hate **you** have raised their heads. They lay crafty plans against **your people**; they consult together against **your treasured ones**. They say, "Come, let us wipe them out as a nation; let the name of Israel be remembered no more!"

Deuteronomy 32:26,27 I said, **I would** scatter them into corners, **I would** make the remembrance of them to cease from among men: Were it not that I feared the wrath of the enemy, lest their adversaries should behave themselves strangely, and lest they should say, Our hand is high, and the Lord hath not done all this.

Isaiah 66:7-9 Before she travailed, she brought forth; before her pain came, she was delivered of a man child. Who hath heard such a thing? who hath seen such things? Shall the earth be made to bring forth in one day? or shall a nation be born at once? for as soon as Zion travailed, she brought forth her children. Shall I bring to the birth, and not cause to bring forth? saith the Lord: shall I cause to bring forth, and shut the womb? saith thy God.

Notes:

Numbers 14:10-12 But all the congregation bade stone them with stones. And the glory of the LORD appeared in the tabernacle of the congregation before all the children of Israel. And the LORD said unto Moses, How long will this people provoke me? and how long will it be ere they believe me, for all the signs which I have showed among them? I will smite them with the pestilence, and **disinherit them**, and **will make of you a greater** nation and mightier than they.

Numbers 14:13-16 And Moses said to the LORD: "Then the Egyptians will hear it, for by Your might You brought these people up from among them, "and they will tell it to the inhabitants of this land. They have heard that You, LORD, are among these people; that You, LORD, are seen face to face and Your cloud stands above them, and You go before them in a pillar of cloud by day and in a pillar of fire by night. "Now if You kill these people as one man, then the nations which have heard of Your fame will speak, saying, '**Because the LORD was not able to bring this people to the land which He swore to give them, therefore He killed them in the wilderness.**'

Genesis 7:2 Of every clean beast you shall take to you by sevens, the male and his female: and of beasts that are not clean by two, the male and his female.

Noah knew difference! Why more of the clean animals? For sacrifice

Genesis 7:4 For **yet seven days**, and I will cause it to rain upon the earth **forty days and forty nights**; and every living substance that I have made will I destroy from off the face of the earth.

Genesis 7:7-11 And Noah went in, and his sons, and his wife, and his sons 'wives with him, into the ark, because of the waters of the flood. Of clean beasts, and of beasts that are not clean, and of fowls, and of every thing that creepeth upon the earth, There went in two and two unto Noah into the ark, the male and the female, as God had commanded Noah. And it came to pass after seven days, that the waters of the flood were upon the earth. In the six hundredth year of Noah's life, in the second month, the seventeenth day of the month, the same day were all the fountains of the great deep broken up, and the windows of heaven were opened.

Genesis 8:3,4 And the waters returned from off the earth continually: and after the end of the hundred and fifty days the waters were abated. And the ark rested in the seventh month, on the seventeenth day of the month, on the mountains of Ararat.

Genesis 8:6-9 And it came to pass at the end of forty days, that Noah opened the window of the ark which he had made: And he sent forth a raven, which went forth to and fro, until the waters were dried up from off the earth. Also he sent forth a dove from him, to see if the waters were abated from off the face of the ground; But the dove found no rest for the sole of her foot, and she returned unto him into the ark, for the waters were on the face of the whole earth: then he put forth his hand, and took her, and pulled her in unto him into the ark.

Notes:

Isaiah 66:1,2 Thus said the LORD, The heaven is my throne, and the earth is my footstool: where is the house that you build to me? and where is the place of my rest? For all those things has my hand made, and all those things have been, said the LORD: but to this man will I look, even to him that is poor and of a contrite spirit, and trembles at my word.

Genesis 8:10,11 And he stayed yet other seven days; and again he sent forth the dove out of the ark; And the dove came in to him in the evening; and, see, in her mouth was an olive leaf plucked off: so Noah knew that the waters were abated from off the earth.

Genesis 8:12 And he stayed yet other seven days; and sent forth the dove; which returned not again to him any more.

The first flight is compared to creation where the Spirit could find no rest, the second flight it rests upon, the branch of Israel, our Righteous Messiah whose life was torn and returned to the Father, and the third time to its finding rest upon the disciples as Yeshua said representing Him sending another "Comforter"!

Genesis 8:13 And it came to pass in the six hundredth and first year, in the first month, the first day of the month, the waters were dried up from off the earth: and Noah removed the covering of the ark, and looked, and, behold, the face of the ground was dry.

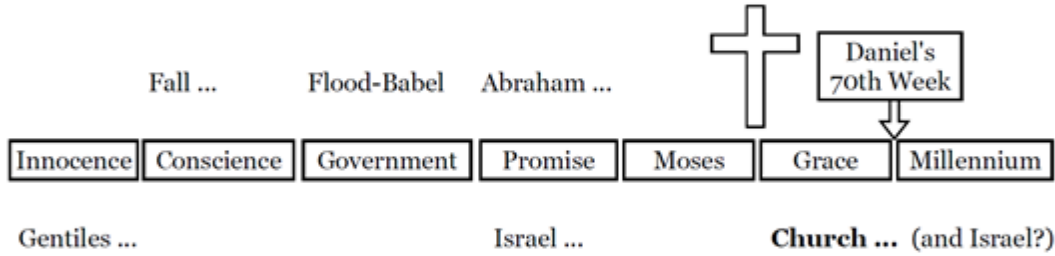

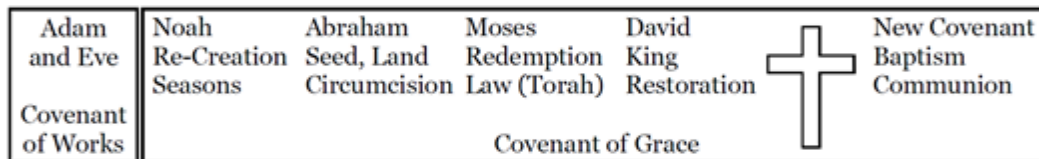

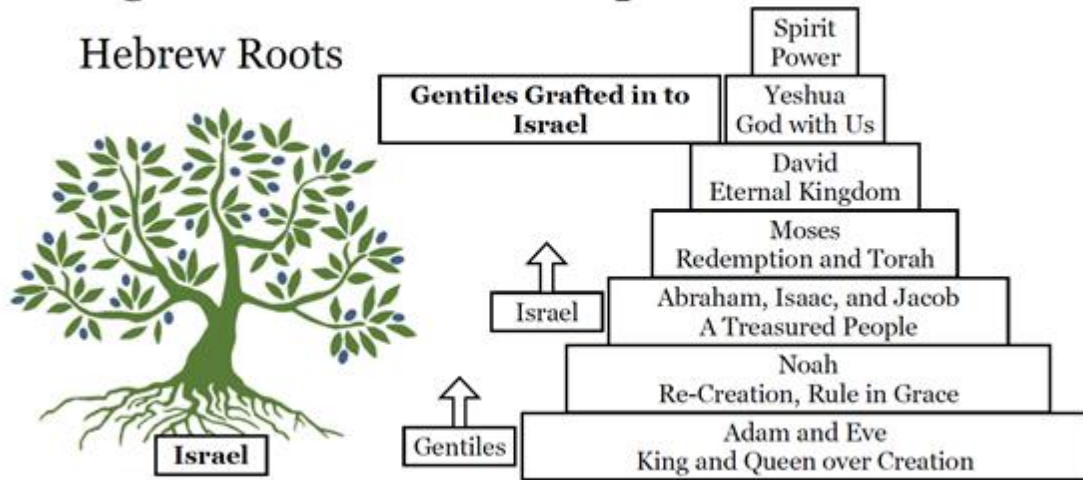
