**Leviticus 16:1** And the LORD spoke unto Moses after the death of the two sons of Aaron, when they drew near before the LORD, and died;

**Leviticus 16:2** And the LORD said to Moses, Speak to Aaron your brother, that he come not at all times into the holy place within the veil before the **mercy seat**, which is on the ark; that he die not: for I will appear in the cloud on **the mercy seat**.

**Hebrews 4:14-16** Having then a great high priest, who has passed through the heavens, Yeshua, the Son of God, let us hold tightly to our confession. For we don’t have a high priest who can’t be touched with the feeling of our infirmities, but one who has been in all points tempted like we are, yet without sin. **Let us therefore draw near with boldness to the throne of grace**, that we may receive **mercy, and may find grace** for help in time of need.

**Leviticus 16:12-14** And he shall take a **censer** full of burning coals of **fire from off the altar** before the LORD, and his hands full of sweet **incense** beaten small, and bring it within the veil: And he shall put the incense upon the fire before the LORD, that the **cloud of the incense** may cover the **mercy seat** כפרת that is on the testimony, that he die not: And he shall take of the blood of the bullock, and sprinkle it with his finger on the **mercy seat** eastward; and before the **mercy seat** shall he sprinkle of the blood with his finger **seven times**.

**Revelation 8:1-6** And when he had opened the seventh seal, there was silence in heaven about the space of half an hour. And I saw the seven angels which stood before God; and to them were given seven trumpets. And another angel came and stood **at the altar**, having a **golden censer**; and there was given to him much **incense**, that he should offer it with **the prayers of all saints** on the golden altar which was before the throne. And the **smoke of the incense**, which came with the prayers of the saints, ascended up before God out of the angel's hand. And the angel took the **censer**, and filled it with **fire of the altar**, and cast it into the earth: and there were voices, and thunder, and lightning, and an earthquake. And the seven angels which had the seven trumpets prepared themselves to sound.

**Exodus 19:9-13** And the LORD said to Moses, See, I come to you in a thick cloud, that the people may hear when I speak with you, and believe you for ever. And Moses told the words of the people to the LORD. And the LORD said to Moses, Go to the people, and sanctify them to day and to morrow, and let them wash their clothes, And be ready against the third day: for **the third day the LORD will come down in the sight of all the people** on mount Sinai. And you shall set bounds to the people round about, saying, Take heed to yourselves, that you go not up into the mount, or touch the border of it: whoever touches the mount shall be surely put to death: There shall not an hand touch it, but he shall surely be stoned, or shot through; whether it be beast or man, it shall not live: when the trumpet sounds long, they shall come up to the mount.

**Mark 13:24-27** But in those days, after that tribulation, the sun shall be darkened, and the moon shall not give her light, And the stars of heaven shall fall, and the powers that are in heaven shall be shaken. And then shall they see the Son of man coming in the clouds with great power and glory. And then shall he send his angels, and shall gather together his elect from the four winds, from the uttermost part of the earth to the uttermost part of heaven.

**Revelation 11:19** And the temple of God was opened in heaven, and there was seen in his temple the ark of his testament: and there were lightning, and voices, and thundering, and an earthquake, and great hail.

**Leviticus 16:30** For on that day shall the priest make an atonement יָכַפֵּר for you, to cleanse you, that ye may be clean from all your sins before the Lord. It shall be a sabbath of rest to you, and ye shall afflict your souls, by a statute for ever.

**Ephesians 5:25-27** Husbands, love your wives, even as Messiah also loved the assembly, and gave himself up for it; that he might sanctify it, having cleansed it by the washing of water with the word, that he might present the assembly to himself gloriously, not having spot or wrinkle or any such thing; but that it should be holy and without blemish.

**Leviticus 16:4** He shall put on the holy linen coat, and he shall have the linen breeches on his flesh, and shall be girded with a linen girdle, and with the linen turban shall he be attired: these are holy garments; therefore shall he wash his flesh in water, and so put them on.

NOTES:

**Revelation 19:13,14** And he was clothed with a clothing dipped in blood: and his name is called The Word of God. And the armies which were in heaven followed him on white horses, clothed in fine linen, white and clean.

**Leviticus 16:7-10** And he shall take the two goats, and present them before the LORD at the door of the tabernacle of the congregation. And Aaron shall cast lots upon the two goats; one lot for the LORD, and the other lot for the scapegoat. And Aaron shall bring the goat on which the LORD'S lot fell, and offer him for a sin offering. But the goat, on which the lot fell to be the scapegoat, shall be presented alive before the LORD, to make an atonement with him, and to let him go for a scapegoat into the wilderness.

**Leviticus 16:16,17** And he shall make an atonement for the holy place, because of the uncleanness of the children of Israel, and because of their transgressions in all their sins: and so shall he do for the tabernacle of the congregation, that remains among them in the middle of their uncleanness. And **there shall be no man in the tabernacle** of the congregation when he goes in to make an atonement in the holy place, until he come out, and have made an atonement for himself, and for his household, and for all the congregation of Israel.

**Revelation 15:4-8** Who shall not fear you, O Lord, and glorify your name? for you only are holy: for all nations shall come and worship before you; for your judgments are made manifest. And after that I looked, and, behold, the temple of the tabernacle of the testimony in heaven was opened: And the seven angels came out of the temple, having the seven plagues, clothed in pure and white linen, and having their breasts girded with golden girdles. And one of the four beasts gave to the seven angels seven golden vials full of the wrath of God, who lives for ever and ever. And the temple was filled with smoke from the glory of God, and from his power; and **no man was able to enter into the temple**, till the seven plagues of the seven angels were fulfilled.

**Revelation 6:10** And they cried with a loud voice, saying, How long, O Lord, holy and true, do you not **judge and avenge our blood** on them that dwell on the earth?

#### **KEDOSHIM – Holy Ones**

**Leviticus 27:14** And when a man shall sanctify his house to be holy unto the Lord

**Leviticus 27:28** Notwithstanding no devoted thing, that a man shall devote unto the Lord of all that he hath, both of man and beast, and of the field of his possession, shall be sold or redeemed: every devoted thing is most holy unto the Lord.

**Leviticus 27:21** But the field, when it goeth out in the jubilee, shall be holy unto the Lord, as a field devoted; the possession thereof shall be the priest's.

NOTES:

**Acts 5:1,2** But a certain man named Hananiah, with Shappirah, his wife, sold a possession, and kept back part of the price, his wife also being aware of it, and brought a certain part, and laid it at the emissaries' feet.

**Acts 5:4,5** While you kept it, didn't it remain your own? After it was sold, wasn't it in your power? How is it that you have conceived this thing in your heart? You haven't lied to men, but to God." Hananiah, hearing these words, fell down and died. Great fear came on all who heard these things.

**Leviticus 19:1,2** And the Lord spake unto Moses, saying, Speak unto all the congregation of the children of Israel, and say unto them, Ye shall be holy: קדש for I the Lord your God am holy. קדוש

**Leviticus 19:3** "Each one of you shall respect his mother and his father. You shall keep my Sabbaths. I am the LORD your God.

**Leviticus 19:9,10** "When you reap the harvest of your land, you shall not wholly reap the corners of your field, neither shall you gather the gleanings of your harvest. You shall not glean your vineyard, neither shall you gather the fallen grapes of your vineyard; you shall leave them for the poor and for the foreigner. I am the LORD your God.

**Leviticus 19:11,12** "You shall not steal. "You shall not lie. "You shall not deceive one another. "You shall not swear by my name falsely, and profane the name of your God. I am the LORD.

**Leviticus 19:13** "You shall not oppress your neighbor, nor rob him. "The wages of a hired servant shall not remain with you all night until the morning.

**Leviticus 19:15** "You shall do no injustice in judgment: you shall not be partial to the poor, nor show favoritism to the great; but you shall judge your neighbor in righteousness.

**Leviticus 19:16-18** "You shall not go up and down as a slanderer among your people. "You shall not endanger the life of your neighbor. I am the LORD. "You shall not hate your brother in your heart. You shall surely rebuke your neighbor, and not bear sin because of him. "You shall not take vengeance, nor bear any grudge against the children of your people; but you shall love your neighbor as yourself. I am the LORD.

**Luke 10:27-29** He answered, "You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, with all your strength, and with all your mind; and your neighbor as yourself." He said to him, "You have answered correctly. Do this, and you will live." But he, desiring to justify himself, asked Yeshua, "Who is my neighbor?"

NOTES:

**Leviticus 19:33,34** 'And if a stranger dwells with you in your land, you shall not mistreat him. 'The stranger who dwells among you shall be to you as one born among you, and you shall love him as yourself; for you were strangers in the land of Egypt: I am the LORD your God.

**Leviticus 19:30** “You shall keep my Sabbaths, and reverence my sanctuary; I am the LORD.

**Leviticus 20:7,8** Sanctify yourselves therefore, and be ye holy: for I am the Lord your God. And ye shall keep my statutes, and do them: I am the Lord which sanctify you. You shall keep my statutes, and do them. I am the LORD who sanctifies you.

**Leviticus 20:23-26** You shall not walk in the customs of the nation, which I am casting out before you: for they did all these things, and therefore I abhorred them. But I have said to you, “You shall inherit their land, and I will give it to you to possess it, a land flowing with milk and honey.” I am the LORD your God, who has separated you from the peoples. “You shall therefore make a distinction between the clean animal and the unclean, and between the unclean fowl and the clean: and you shall not make yourselves abominable by animal, or by bird, or by anything with which the ground teems, which I have separated from you as unclean for you. You shall be holy to me: for I, the LORD, am holy, and have set you apart from the peoples, that you should be mine.

**1 Peter 1:15,16** But as he which hath called you is holy, so be ye holy in all manner of conversation; Because it is written, Be ye holy; for I am holy.

**Ephesians 1:4** According as he hath chosen us in him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and without blame before him in love:

**Ephesians 5:27** That he might present it to himself a glorious assembly, not having spot, or wrinkle, or any such thing; but that it should be holy and without blemish.

**Hebrews 12:14** Follow peace with all men, and holiness, without which no man shall see the Lord:

**Revelations 22:11** He that is unjust, let him be unjust still: and he which is filthy, let him be filthy still: and he that is righteous, let him be righteous still: and he that is holy, let him be holy still.

**Isaiah 65:1-5** “I am inquired of by those who didn’t ask; I am found by those who didn’t seek me: I said, See me, see me, to a nation that was not called by my name. I have spread out my hands all the day to a rebellious people, who walk in a way that is not good, after their own thoughts; a people who provoke me to my face continually, sacrificing in gardens, and burning incense on bricks; who sit among the graves, and lodge in the secret places; who eat pig’s flesh, and broth of abominable things is in their vessels; who say, Stand by yourself, don’t come near to me, for I am holier than you. These are a smoke in my nose, a fire that burns all the day.

NOTES:

**Isaiah 57:15** For thus says the high and lofty One who inhabits eternity, whose name is Holy: “I dwell in the high and holy place, with him also who is of a contrite and humble spirit, to revive the spirit of the humble, and to revive the heart of the contrite.

**Luke 4:33,34** And in the synagogue there was a man, which had a spirit of an unclean devil, and cried out with a loud voice, Saying, Let us alone; what have we to do with thee, thou Jesus of Nazareth? art thou come to destroy us? I know thee who thou art; the Holy One of God

**Amos 9:8-10** Behold, the eyes of the Lord GOD are on the sinful kingdom, and I will destroy it from off the surface of the earth; except that I will not utterly destroy the house of Jacob,” says the LORD. “For, behold, I will command, and I will sift the house of Israel among all the nations, as grain is sifted in a sieve, yet not the least kernel will fall on the earth. **All the sinners of my people will die by the sword, who say, ‘Evil won’t overtake nor meet us.’**

**Amos 9:11,12** In that day I will raise up the tent of David who is fallen, and close up its breaches, and I will raise up its ruins, and I will build it as in the days of old; that they may possess the remnant of Edom, and all the nations who are called by my name,” says the LORD who does this.

**Acts 15:14-18** Simeon hath declared how God at the first did visit the Gentiles, to take out of them a people for his name. And to this agree the words of the prophets; **as it is written**, After this I will return, and will build again the tabernacle of David, which is fallen down; and I will build again the ruins thereof, and I will set it up: That the residue of men might seek after the Lord, and all the Gentiles, upon whom my name is called, saith the Lord, who doeth all these things. Known unto God are all his works from the beginning of the world.

**Acts 15:19-21** Wherefore my sentence is, that we trouble not them, which from among the Gentiles are turned to God: But that we write unto them, that they abstain from pollutions of idols, and from fornication, and from things strangled, and from blood. For Moses of old time hath in every city them that preach him, being read in the synagogues every sabbath day.

**Amos 9:14,15** I will bring my people Israel back from captivity, and they will rebuild the ruined cities, and inhabit them; and they will plant vineyards, and drink wine from them. They shall also make gardens, and eat their fruit. I will plant them on their land, and **they will no more be plucked up out of their land which I have given them,**” says the **LORD your God.**
