Jeremiah 33:17,18 For thus says the LORD: David shall never want a man to sit on the throne of the house of Israel; neither shall **the priests the Levites** want a man before me **to offer burnt offerings, and to burn meal offerings, and to do sacrifice continually.**

Ezekiel 44:1,2 Then he brought me back the way of the gate of the outward sanctuary which looks toward the east; and it was shut. Then said the Lord to me; This gate shall be shut, it shall not be opened, and no man shall enter in by it; because the LORD, the God of Israel, hath entered in by it, therefore it shall be shut.

Ezekiel 44:10-11a And the Levites that are gone away far from me, when Israel went astray, which went astray away from me after their idols; they shall even bear their iniquity. Yet they shall be ministers in my sanctuary, having charge at the gates of the house, and ministering to the house:

Ezekiel 44:15,16 But the priests the Levites, **the sons of Zadok**, that kept the charge of my sanctuary when the children of Israel went astray from me, **they shall come near to me** to minister unto me, and **they shall stand before me** to offer to me the fat and the blood, said the Lord GOD: **They shall enter into my sanctuary**, and **they shall come near** to my table, to minister to me, and **they shall keep my charge.**

Ezekiel 44:23,24 And they shall teach my people the difference between the holy and profane, and cause them to discern between the unclean and the clean. And in controversy they shall stand in judgment; and they shall judge it according to my judgments: and they shall keep my laws and my statutes in all mine assemblies; and they shall hallow my Sabbaths.

Leviticus 21:16-18a And the LORD spoke to Moses, saying, Speak to Aaron, saying, Whoever he be of your seed in their generations that has any blemish, let him not approach to offer the bread of his God. For whatever man he be that has a blemish, he shall not approach:

Leviticus 22:20 But whatever has a blemish that shall you not offer: for it shall not be acceptable for you.

Malachi 1:8,9 When you offer the blind for sacrifice, isn't that evil? And when you offer the lame and sick, isn't that evil? Present it now to your governor! Will he be pleased with you? Or will he accept your person?" says the LORD of Hosts. "Now, please entreat the favor of God, that he may be gracious to us. With this, will he accept any of you?" says the LORD of Hosts.

Leviticus 23:1,2 And the Lord spoke to Moses, saying, Speak to the children of Israel, and say to them, Concerning the feasts of the LORD, which you shall proclaim to be holy convocations, even these are my feasts.

NOTES:

Leviticus 23:27,28 “However on the tenth day of this seventh month is Yom Kippur: it shall be a holy convocation to you, and you shall afflict yourselves; and you shall offer an offering made by fire to the LORD. You shall do no kind of work in that same day; for it is Yom Kippur, to make atonement for you before the LORD your God.

Leviticus 16:21 Aaron shall lay both his hands on the head of the live goat, and confess over him all the iniquities of the children of Israel, and all their transgressions, even all their sins; and he shall put them on the head of the goat, and shall send him away into the wilderness by the hand of a man who is in readiness.

Leviticus 16:30 for on this day shall **atonement** be made for you, to **cleanse** you; from all your sins you shall be clean before the LORD.

Kaper כפר doesn't only mean atonement

Genesis 6:14 Make a ship of gopher wood. You shall make rooms in the ship, and shall **seal** it inside and outside with **pitch**.

Leviticus 1:2-4 “Speak to the children of Israel, and tell them, ‘When anyone of you offers an offering to the LORD, you shall offer your offering of the livestock, from the herd and from the flock. “‘If his offering is a burnt offering from the herd, he shall offer a male without blemish. He shall offer it at the door of the Tent of Meeting, that he may be accepted before the LORD. He shall lay his hand on the head of the burnt offering, and it shall be accepted for him to make **atonement** for him.

Leviticus 12:6,7 “‘When the days of her purification are completed, for a son, or for a daughter, she shall bring to the priest at the door of the Tent of Meeting, a year old lamb for a burnt offering, and a young pigeon, or a turtledove, for a sin offering: and he shall offer it before the LORD, and make **atonement** for her;

Numbers 35:31 “‘Moreover you shall take no ransom for the life of a murderer who is guilty of death; but he shall surely be put to death.

Exodus 21:28-30 “If a bull gores a man or a woman to death, the bull shall surely be stoned, and its flesh shall not be eaten; but the owner of the bull shall not be held responsible. But if the bull had a habit of goring in the past, and it has been testified to its owner, and he has not kept it in, but it has killed a man or a woman, the bull shall be stoned, and its owner shall also be put to death. If a **ransom** is laid on him, then he shall give for the redemption of his life whatever is laid on him.

Romans 6:23 For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life in Messiah Yeshua our Lord.

NOTES:

Psalms 49:6-9 Those who trust in their wealth, and boast in the multitude of their riches— none of them can by any means redeem his brother, nor give God a ransom for him. For the redemption of their life is costly, no payment is ever enough, That he should live on forever, that he should not see corruption.

Exodus 25:21,22 You shall put the mercy seat on top of the ark, and in the ark you shall put the testimony that I will give you. There I will meet with you, and I will tell you from above the mercy seat, from between the two cherubim which are on the ark of the testimony, **all that I command you** for the children of Israel.

Psalms 73:27,28 For, behold, those who are far from you shall perish. You have destroyed all those who are unfaithful to you. But it is good for me to **come close** to God. I have made the Lord the LORD my refuge, that I may tell of all your works.

Numbers 28:2 “Command the children of Israel, and tell them, ‘My offering, **my food** for my offerings made by fire, of a pleasant aroma to me, you shall observe to offer to me in their due season.’

Isaiah 43:23,24 You have not brought me of your sheep for burnt offerings; neither have you honored me with your sacrifices. I have not burdened you with offerings, nor wearied you with frankincense. You have bought me no sweet cane with money, nor have you filled me with the fat of your sacrifices; but you have burdened me with your sins. You have wearied me with your iniquities.

Genesis 46:33,34 It will happen, when Pharaoh summons you, and will say, ‘What is your occupation?’ that you shall say, ‘Your servants have been keepers of livestock from our youth even until now, both we, and our fathers:’ that you may dwell in the land of Goshen; for every shepherd is an abomination to the Egyptians.”

Isaiah 56:7 “My House shall be called *a house of prayer* for all peoples”.
