Deuteronomy 1:1-3 These are the words which Moses spoke to all Israel beyond the Jordan in the wilderness, in the Arabah over against Suf, between Paran, and Tophel, and Laban, and Hazeroth, and Dizahab. It is eleven days’ journey from Horeb by the way of Mount Seir to Kadesh Barnea. It happened **in the fortieth year, in the eleventh month, on the first day of the month**, that Moses spoke to the children of Israel, according to all that the LORD had given him in commandment to them;

Deuteronomy 34:5-8 So Moses the servant of the LORD died there in the land of Moab, according to the word of the LORD. And he buried him in a valley in the land of Moab, over against Beth-peor: but no man knoweth of his sepulchre unto this day. And Moses was an **hundred and twenty years old when he died**: his eye was not dim, nor his natural force abated. And the children of Israel **wept for Moses in the plains of Moab thirty days**: so the days of weeping and mourning for Moses were ended.

Joshua 1:1,2 Now it happened **after the death of Moses** the servant of the LORD, that the LORD spoke to Joshua the son of Nun, Moses’ servant, saying, “Moses my servant is dead; now therefore arise, go over this Jordan, you, and all this people, to the land which I give to them, even to the children of Israel.

Joshua 4:18-19 And it came to pass, when the priests that bare the ark of the covenant of the LORD were come up out of the midst of Jordan, and the soles of the priests' feet were lifted up unto the dry land, that the waters of Jordan returned unto their place, and flowed over all his banks, as they did before. And the people came up out of Jordan on the **tenth day of the first month**, and encamped in Gilgal, in the east border of Jericho.

THE COVENANT

Deuteronomy 4:23 Take heed unto yourselves, **lest ye forget the covenant** of the LORD your God, which he made with you, and make you a graven image, or the likeness of any thing, which the LORD thy God hath forbidden thee.

Deuteronomy 5:2,3 The LORD our God **made a covenant with us in Horeb**. The LORD didn't make this covenant with our fathers, but with us, even us, who are all of us here alive this day.

Deuteronomy 8:18 But you shall remember the LORD your God, for it is he who gives you power to get wealth; that he may establish his covenant which he swore to your fathers, as at this day.

REMEMBER

THE LAW (TORAH)

Deuteronomy 4:9-13 Only take heed to thyself, and keep thy soul diligently, **lest thou forget** the things which thine eyes have seen, and lest they depart from thy heart all the days of thy life: but **teach them thy sons, and thy sons' sons; Especially the day that thou stoodest before the LORD** thy God in Horeb, when the LORD said unto me, Gather me the people together, and **I will make them hear my words**, that they may learn to fear me all the days that they shall live upon the earth, and that they may teach their children. And ye came near and stood under the mountain; and the mountain burned with fire unto the midst of heaven, with darkness, clouds, and thick darkness. And the LORD spake unto you out of the midst of the fire: ye heard the voice of the words, but saw no similitude; only ye heard a voice. And **he declared unto you his covenant**, which he commanded you to perform, even ten commandments; and he wrote them upon two tables of stone.

Remember the feast of Shavuot – wedding ceremony! Not Moses covenant!

Jeremiah 3:14 "Return, backsliding children," says the LORD; "for I am a husband to you.

THEIR PAST SLAVERY

Deuteronomy 5:15 And **remember that thou wast a servant** in the land of Egypt, and that the LORD thy God brought thee out thence through a mighty hand and by a stretched out arm: therefore the LORD thy God commanded thee to keep the sabbath day.

NOTES:

THEIR GREAT DELIVERENCE

Deuteronomy 7:17-19 If thou shalt say in thine heart, These nations are more than I; how can I dispossess them? Thou shalt not be afraid of them: but **shalt well remember what the LORD thy God did unto Pharaoh, and unto all Egypt;** The great temptations which thine eyes saw, and the signs, and the wonders, and the mighty hand, and the stretched out arm, whereby the LORD thy God brought thee out: so shall the LORD thy God do unto all the people of whom thou art afraid.

DIVINE LEADERSHIP

Deuteronomy 8:2 And thou **shalt remember all the way which the LORD thy God led thee these forty years in the wilderness,** to humble thee, and to prove thee, to know what was in thine heart, whether thou wouldest keep his commandments, or no.

PAST REBELLION

Deuteronomy 9:7 Remember, and forget not, how thou provokedst the LORD thy God to wrath in the wilderness: from the day that thou didst depart out of the land of Egypt, until ye came unto this place, ye have been rebellious against the LORD.

DIVINE JUDGEMENTS

Deuteronomy 24:9 Remember what the LORD thy God did unto Miriam by the way, after that ye were come forth out of Egypt.

THEIR PAST

Deuteronomy 32:7-8 Remember the days of old, consider the years of many generations: ask thy father, and he will shew thee; thy elders, and they will tell thee. When the most High divided to the nations their inheritance, when he separated the sons of Adam, he set the bounds of the people according to the number of the children of Israel.

LOVE

Deuteronomy 7:6-9 For thou art an holy people unto the LORD thy God: the LORD thy God **hath chosen thee to be a special people unto himself,** above all people that are upon the face of the earth. The LORD did not set his love upon you, nor choose you, because ye were more in number than any people; for ye were the fewest of all people: But **because the LORD loved you,** and because he would keep the oath which he had sworn unto your fathers, hath the LORD brought you out with a mighty hand, and redeemed you out of the house of bondmen, from the hand of Pharaoh king of Egypt. Know therefore that the LORD thy God, he is God, the faithful God, which **keepeth covenant and mercy with them that love him and keep his commandments to a thousand generations;**

NOTES:

Deuteronomy 10:12-16 And now, Israel, what doth the LORD thy God require of thee, but **to fear the LORD thy God, to walk in all his ways, and to love him, and to serve the LORD thy God with all thy heart and with all thy soul, To keep the commandments of the LORD, and his statutes, which I command thee this day for thy good?** Behold, the heaven and the heaven of heavens is the LORD's thy God, the earth also, with all that therein is. Only the LORD had a delight in thy fathers **to love them**, and he chose their seed after them, even you above all people, as it is this day. Circumcise therefore the foreskin of your heart, and be no more stiffnecked.

1 John 4:18-19 There is **no fear in love**; but perfect love casteth out fear: because fear hath torment. He that feareth is not made perfect in love. We love him, **because he first loved us**.

Deuteronomy 1:21 Behold, the LORD your God has set the land before you: go up and possess it, as the LORD God of your fathers has said to you; **fear not**, neither be discouraged.

Deuteronomy 2:19-21 And when you come near over against the children of Ammon, distress them not, nor meddle with them: for I will not give you of the land of the children of Ammon any possession; because I have given it to the children of Lot for a possession. That also was accounted a land of giants: giants dwelled therein in old time; and the Ammonites call them Zamzummims; A people great, and many, and tall, as the Anakims; but the LORD destroyed them before them; and they succeeded them, and dwelled in their stead:

Deuteronomy 3:2a And the LORD said to me, **Fear him not**: for I will deliver him, and all his people, and his land, into your hand;

Deuteronomy 3:22 You shall **not fear them**: for the LORD your God he shall fight for you.

1 John 4:18,19 There is **no fear in love**; but perfect love casts out fear, because fear has punishment. He who fears is not made perfect in love. We love him, because he first loved us.

Deuteronomy 5:10 And showing mercy to thousands of them that **love me and keep my commandments**.

1 John 5:2,3 By this we know that **we love** the children of God, when **we love** God, **and keep his commandments**. For this **is the love of God, that we keep his commandments**: and his commandments **are not grievous**.

Matthew 25:24-26 Then he which had received the one talent came and said, Lord, I knew thee that thou art an hard man, reaping where thou hast not sown, and gathering where thou hast not strawed: And **I was afraid**, and went and hid thy talent in the earth: lo, there thou hast that is thine. His lord answered and said unto him, Thou wicked and slothful servant, thou knewest that I reap where I sowed not, and gather where I have not strawed:

NOTES:

Deuteronomy 1:22-27 And ye came near unto me every one of you, and said, We will send men before us, and they shall search us out the land, and bring us word again by what way we must go up, and into what cities we shall come. And the saying pleased me well: and I took twelve men of you, one of a tribe: And they turned and went up into the mountain, and came unto the valley of Eshcol, and searched it out. And they took of the fruit of the land in their hands, and brought it down unto us, and brought us word again, and said, It is a good land which the LORD our God doth give us. Notwithstanding ye would not go up, but rebelled against the commandment of the LORD your God: And ye murmured in your tents, and said, **Because the LORD hated us**, he hath brought us forth out of the land of Egypt, to deliver us into the hand of the Amorites, to destroy us.

Deuteronomy 7:13 And he will love you, and bless you, and multiply you: he will also bless the fruit of your womb, and the fruit of your land, your corn, and your wine, and your oil, the increase of your cows, and the flocks of your sheep, in the land which he swore to your fathers to give you.

Deuteronomy 1:30-34 The LORD your God which goes before you, he shall fight for you, according to all that he did for you in Egypt before your eyes; And in the wilderness, where you have seen how that the LORD your God bore you, as a man does bear his son, in all the way that you went, until you came into this place. Yet in this thing **you did not believe** the LORD your God, Who went in the way before you, to search you out a place to pitch your tents in, in fire by night, to show you by what way you should go, and in a cloud by day. And the LORD heard the voice of your words, and was wroth, and sware, saying,

Deuteronomy 10:12 And now, Israel, what does the LORD your God require of you, but to fear the LORD your God, to walk in all his ways, and **to love him**, and to serve the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul,

Deuteronomy 30:6 And the LORD your God will circumcise your heart, and the heart of your seed, **to love the LORD** your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, that you may live.

Deuteronomy 30:16 In that I command you this day **to love the LORD** your God, to walk in his ways, and to keep his commandments and his statutes and his judgments, that you may live and multiply: and the LORD your God shall bless you in the land where you go to possess it.

Love letter - These are just too grievous!

Deuteronomy 6:5 And you shall love the LORD your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your might.

SHEMA

Deuteronomy 6:4,5 Hear, O Israel: The LORD our God is one LORD: And you shall love the LORD your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your might.

NOTES:

Deuteronomy 30:11-15 For this commandment which I command you this day, it is not hidden from you, neither is it far off. It is not in heaven, that you should say, Who shall go up for us to heaven, and bring it to us, that we may **hear it, and do it?** Neither is it beyond the sea, that you should say, Who shall go over the sea for us, and bring it to us, that we may hear it, and do it? But the word is very near to you, in your mouth, and in your heart, that you may do it. See, I have set before you this day life and good, and death and evil;

Deuteronomy 30:17,18 But if your heart turn away, so that you **will not hear**, but shall be drawn away, and worship other gods, and serve them; I denounce to you this day, that you shall surely perish, and that you shall not prolong your days on the land, where you pass over Jordan to go to possess it.

Revelation 2:4,5,7 But I have this against you, that you left your first **love. Remember** therefore from where you have fallen, and **repent and do the first works**; or else I am coming to you swiftly, and will move your menorah out of its place, unless you repent. He who has an ear, let him **hear** what the Spirit says to the assemblies. To him who overcomes I will give to eat of the tree of life, which is in the Paradise of my God.

Matthew 4:3-4 The tempter came and said to him, "If you are the Son of God, command that these stones become bread." But he answered, "**It is written**, 'Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceeds out of the mouth of God.'"

Deuteronomy 8:3 And he humbled thee, and suffered thee to hunger, and fed thee with manna, which thou knewest not, neither did thy fathers know; that he might make thee know that man doth not live by bread only, but by every word that proceedeth out of the mouth of the LORD doth man live.

Matthew 4:5-7 Then the devil took him into the holy city. He set him on the pinnacle of the temple, and said to him, "If you are the Son of God, throw yourself down, for it is written, 'He will put his angels in charge of you.' and, 'On their hands they will bear you up, so that you don't dash your foot against a stone.'" Yeshua said to him, "Again, **it is written**, 'You shall not test the Lord, your God.'"

Deuteronomy 6:16 Ye shall not tempt the LORD your God, as ye tempted him in Massah.

Matthew 4:8-10 Again, the devil took him to an exceedingly high mountain, and showed him all the kingdoms of the world, and their glory. He said to him, "I will give you all of these things, if you will fall down and worship me." Then Yeshua said to him, "Get behind me, Satan! For **it is written**, 'You shall worship the Lord your God, and you shall serve him only.'"

NOTES:

Deuteronomy 6:13 Thou shalt fear the LORD thy God, and serve him, and shalt swear by his name.

Matthew 22:35-38 One of them, a Torah scholar, asked him a question, testing him. “Rabbi, which is the greatest commandment in the law?” Yeshua said to him, “‘You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind.’ This is the first and great commandment.

Deuteronomy 6:4-5 Hear, O Israel: The LORD our God is one LORD: And thou shalt love the LORD thy God with all thine heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy might.

Exodus 17:11,12 And it came to pass, when Moses held up his hand, that Israel prevailed: and when he let down his hand, Amalek prevailed. But Moses hands were heavy; and they took a stone, and put it under him, and he sat thereon; and Aaron and Hur stayed up his hands, the one on the one side, and the other on the other side; and his hands were steady until the going down of the sun.

Deuteronomy 32:4 The Rock, his work is perfect, for all his ways are justice: a God of faithfulness and without iniquity, just and right is he.

Deuteronomy 32:4 [He is] the Rock, his work is perfect: for all his ways are judgment: a God of truth and without iniquity, just and right is he.

Exodus 4:30,31 And Aaron spoke all the words which the LORD had spoken to Moses, and did the signs in the sight of the people. And the people **believed**: and when they heard that the LORD had visited the children of Israel, and that he had looked on their affliction, then they bowed their heads and worshipped.

Amen – believe God **empathizes with them, He shows He loves them**

Exodus 14:31 And Israel saw that great work which the LORD did on the Egyptians: and the people feared the LORD, and believed the LORD, and his servant Moses.

Exodus 19:9 And the LORD said to Moses, See, I come to you in a thick cloud, that the people may hear when I speak with you, and **believe** you for ever. And Moses told the words of the people to the LORD.

Deuteronomy 29:9-15 Keep therefore the words of **this covenant**, and do them, that you may prosper in all that you do. You stand this day all of you before the LORD your God; your heads, your tribes, your elders, and your officers, even all the men of Israel, your little ones, your wives, and your foreigner who is in the midst of your camps, from the one who cuts your wood to the one who draws your water; that you may enter **into the covenant** of the LORD your God, and into his oath, which the LORD your God makes with you this day; that **he may establish you this day to**

himself for a people, and that he may be to you a God, as he spoke to you, and as he swore to your fathers, to Abraham, to Isaac, and to Jacob. Neither with you only do I make **this covenant** and this oath, but with him who stands here with us this day before the LORD our God, **and also with him who is not here with us this day!**

Ezekiel 36:22-33 Therefore tell the house of Israel, Thus says the Lord GOD: I don't do [this] for your sake, house of Israel, but for my holy name, which you have profaned among the nations, where you went. **I will** sanctify my great name, which has been profaned among the nations, which you have profaned in their midst; and the nations shall know that I am the LORD, says the Lord GOD, when I shall be sanctified in you before their eyes. For **I will** take you from among the nations, and gather you out of all the countries, and will bring you into your own land. **I will** sprinkle clean water on you, and you shall be clean: from all your filthiness, and from all your idols, **will I** cleanse you. **I will** also give you a new heart, and **I will** put a new spirit within you; and **I will** take away the stony heart out of your flesh, and **I will** give you a heart of flesh. **I will** put my Spirit within you, and cause you to walk in my statutes, and you shall keep my ordinances, and do them. You shall dwell in the land that I gave to your fathers; and you shall be my people, and **I will** be your God. **I will** save you from all your uncleanness: and **I will** call for the grain, and will multiply it, and lay no famine on you. **I will** multiply the fruit of the tree, and the increase of the field, that you may receive no more the reproach of famine among the nations. Then you shall remember your evil ways, and your doings that were not good; and you shall loathe yourselves in your own sight for your iniquities and for your abominations. Nor for your sake do I this, says the Lord GOD, be it known to you: be ashamed and confounded for your ways, house of Israel. Thus says the Lord GOD: In the day that I cleanse you from all your iniquities, **I will** cause the cities to be inhabited, and the waste places shall be built.

Haftarah -

Isaiah 1:1-4 The vision of Isaiah the son of Amoz, which he saw concerning Judah and Jerusalem, in the days of Uzziah, Jotham, Ahaz, and Hezekiah, kings of Judah. Hear, heavens, and listen, earth; for the LORD has spoken: "I have nourished and brought up children, and they have rebelled against me. The ox knows his owner, and the donkey his master's crib; but Israel doesn't know, my people don't consider." Ah sinful nation, a people loaded with iniquity, a seed of evildoers, children who deal corruptly! They have forsaken the LORD. They have despised the Holy One of Israel. They are estranged and backward.

Isaiah 1:7-10 Your country is desolate. Your cities are burned with fire. Strangers devour your land in your presence, and it is desolate, as overthrown by strangers. The daughter of Zion is left like a shelter in a vineyard, like a hut in a field of melons, like a besieged city. Unless the LORD of Hosts had left to us a very small remnant, we would have been as Sodom; we would have been like Gomorrah. Hear the word of the LORD, you rulers of Sodom! Listen to the law of our God, you people of Gomorrah!

NOTES:

Isaiah 1:11-16 “What are the multitude of your sacrifices to me?” says the LORD. “I have had enough of the burnt offerings of rams, and the fat of fed animals. I don’t delight in the blood of bulls, or of lambs, or of male goats. When you come to appear before me, who has required this at your hand, to trample my courts? Bring no more vain offerings. Incense is an abomination to me; new moons, Sabbaths, and convocations: I can’t bear with evil assemblies. My soul hates your New Moons and your appointed feasts. They are a burden to me. I am weary of bearing them. When you spread forth your hands, I will hide my eyes from you. Yes, when you make many prayers, I will not hear. Your hands are full of blood. Wash yourselves, make yourself clean. Put away the evil of your doings from before my eyes. Cease to do evil.

Lamentations 2:9 Her gates are sunk into the ground; he has destroyed and broken her bars: her king and her princes are among the Gentiles: **the law is no more; her prophets also find no vision from the LORD.**

Proverbs 29:18 Where there is no vision, the people perish: but he that keeps the law, happy is he.

Proverbs 6:23 For the commandment is a lamp; and the law is light.

Matthew 25:8 And the foolish said unto the wise, Give us of your oil; for our lamps are gone out.
