Deuteronomy 3:23-25 I begged the LORD at that time, saying, "Lord the LORD, you have begun to show your servant your greatness, and your strong hand: for what god is there in heaven or in earth, that can do according to your works, and according to your mighty acts? **Please let me go over and see the good land** that is beyond the Jordan, that goodly mountain, and Lebanon."

Deuteronomy 3:26,27 But the LORD was angry with me for your sakes, and didn't listen to me; and the LORD said to me, "Let it suffice you; speak no more to me of this matter. Go up to the top of Pisgah, and lift up your eyes westward, and northward, and southward, and eastward, and see with your eyes: for you shall not go over this Jordan.

Deuteronomy 4:1,2 Now, Israel, listen to the statutes and to the ordinances, which I teach you, to do them; that you may live, and go in and possess the land which the LORD, the God of your fathers, gives you. You shall not add to the word which I command you, neither shall you diminish from it, that you may keep the commandments of the LORD your God which I command you.

Revelation 22:18,19 For I testify to every man that hears the words of the prophecy of this book, if any man shall add to these things, God shall add to him the plagues that are written in this book: And if any man shall take away from the words of the book of this prophecy, God shall take away his part out of the book of life, and out of the holy city, and from the things which are written in this book.

Deuteronomy 4:4 But you that did cleave unto the LORD your God are alive every one of you this day.

Genesis 2:24 Therefore shall a man leave his father and his mother, and shall cleave unto his wife: and they shall be one flesh.

Matthew 11:29 Take my yoke upon you, and learn of me; for I am meek and lowly in heart: and ye shall find rest unto your souls. For my yoke is easy, and my burden is light.

Deuteronomy 4:5-8 Behold, I have taught you statutes and ordinances, even as the LORD my God commanded me, that you should do so in the midst of the land where you go in to possess it. **Keep** therefore and **do** them; **for this is your wisdom and your understanding in the sight of the peoples, who shall hear all these statutes, and say, "Surely this great nation is a wise and understanding people."** For what great nation is there, that has a god so near to them, as the LORD our God is whenever we call on him? What great nation is there, that has statutes and ordinances so righteous as all this law, which I set before you this day?

Deuteronomy 4:28-31 But from there you will seek the Lord your God and you will find him, if you search after him with all your heart and with all your soul. When you are in tribulation, and all these things come upon you in the latter days, you will return to the Lord your God and obey his voice. For the Lord your God is a merciful God. He will not leave you or destroy you or forget the covenant with your fathers that he swore to them.

Deuteronomy 5:29 O that there were such an heart in them, that they would fear me, and keep all my commandments always, that it might be well with them, and with their children forever!

Deuteronomy 6:4,5 Hear, Israel: the LORD is our God; the LORD is one: and you shall love the LORD your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your might.

NOTES:

Deuteronomy 6:6-9 These words, which I command you this day, **shall be on your heart;** and you shall teach them **diligently** to your children, and shall talk of them when you sit in your house, and when you walk by the way, and when you lie down, and when you rise up. You shall bind them for a sign on your hand, and they shall be for symbols between your eyes. You shall write them on the **doorposts** of your house, and on your gates.

Psalms 2:12 Kiss the Son, lest he be angry, and ye perish from the way, when his wrath is kindled but a little. Blessed are all they that put their trust in him.

Deuteronomy 6:24,25 The LORD commanded us to do all these statutes, to fear the LORD our God, for our good always, that he might preserve us alive, as at this day. It shall be righteousness to us, if we observe to do all this commandment before the LORD our God, as he has commanded us.”

Deuteronomy 7:9 Know therefore that the LORD thy God, he is God, the faithful God, which keepeth covenant and mercy with them that love him and keep his commandments to a thousand generations;

Isaiah 40:1,2 **Comfort ye, comfort ye my people,** saith your God. Speak ye comfortably to Jerusalem, and cry unto her, that her warfare is accomplished, that her iniquity is pardoned: for she hath received of the LORD'S hand double for all her sins.

Isaiah 40:3,4 The voice of him that crieth in the wilderness, **Prepare ye the way of the LORD,** make straight in the desert a highway for our God. Every valley shall be exalted, and every mountain and hill shall be made low: and the crooked shall be made straight, and the rough places plain:

John 1:23 He said, I am the voice of one crying in the wilderness, Make straight the way of the Lord, as said the prophet Isaiah.

Isaiah 40:5 And the Glory of the LORD shall be revealed, and all flesh shall see it(him) together: for the mouth of the LORD hath spoken it.

(JPS) **Isaiah 40:5** The Presence of the Lord shall appear, And all flesh, as one, shall Behold—For the Lord Himself has spoken.”!

John 1:29a The next day, he saw Yeshua coming to him, and said, “**Behold, the Lamb of God,**

John 1:14 And the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us, (and we Beheld His Glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father,) full of grace and truth.

NOTES:

Isaiah 40:6-9 The voice said, Cry. And he said, What shall I cry? All flesh is grass, and all the goodness thereof is as the flower of the field: The grass withereth, the flower fadeth: because the spirit of the LORD bloweth upon it: surely the people are grass. The grass withereth, the flower fadeth: but **the Word of our God shall stand for ever**. O Zion, that bringest **good tidings**, get thee up into the high mountain; O Jerusalem, that bringest **good tidings**, lift up thy voice with strength; lift it up, be not afraid; say unto the cities of Judah, **Behold your God!**

1Peter 1:23-25 Being born again, not of corruptible seed, but of incorruptible, **by the Word of God, which liveth and abideth for ever**. For all flesh is as grass, and all the glory of man as the flower of grass. The grass withereth, and the flower thereof falleth away: But the **Word of the Lord endureth forever**. And **this is the word** which by **the gospel is preached unto you**.

Ecclesiastes 3:1-8 For **everything** there is a season, **and a time** for **every purpose** under heaven: a time to be born, and a time to die; a time to plant, and a time to pluck up that which is planted; a time to kill, and a time to heal; a time to break down, and a time to build up; a time to weep, and a time to laugh; a time to mourn, and a time to dance; a time to cast away stones, and a time to gather stones together; a time to embrace, and a time to refrain from embracing; a time to seek, and a time to lose; a time to keep, and a time to cast away; a time to tear, and a time to sew; a time to keep silence, and a time to speak; a time to love, and a time to hate; a time for war, and a time for peace.

Romans 9:17 For the Scripture says to Pharaoh, "**For this very purpose** I caused you to be raised up, that I might show in you my power, and that my name might be proclaimed in all the earth."

Psalms 137:1-4 By the rivers of Babylon, there we sat down. Yes, **we wept**, when we remembered Zion. On the willows in its midst, we hung up our harps. For there, those who led us captive asked us for songs. Those who tormented us demanded songs of joy: "Sing us one of the songs of Zion!" How can we sing the LORD's song in a foreign land?

Psalms 126:1 When the LORD **brought back those who returned to Zion**, we were like those who **dream**.

Psalms 126:2a Then our mouth was filled with laughter, and our tongue with singing.

Psalms 126:2b Then they said among the nations, "The LORD has done great things for them."

Psalms 126:3 The LORD has done great things for us, and we are glad.

Psalms 126:4 Turn our captivity, O LORD, like **the (Flash floods) streams** in the Negev.

NOTES:

Psalms 126:5 Those who sow in tears will reap in joy.

Psalms 126:6 He who goes out and **weeps** carrying a bag of precious seed for sowing, will certainly come again with joy, carrying his **sheaves**.

Genesis 37:6,7 He said to them, “Please hear this **dream** which I have dreamed: for behold, we were binding sheaves in the field, and behold, my sheaf arose and also stood upright; and behold, your **sheaves** אֶלְמַתֵּיךָ came around, and **bowed down to my sheaf.**”

Genesis 45:1 Then Joseph **couldn't control himself** לִהְתְּאֵפֵק before all those who stood before him, and he cried, “Cause everyone to go out from me!” No one else stood with him, while Joseph made himself known to his brothers.

Genesis 37:35 All his sons and all his daughters rose up to comfort him, but he **refused to be comforted**. He said, “For I will go down to Sheol to my son mourning.” His father wept בָּכָה for him.

Zechariah 12:9-11 And it shall come to pass in that day, that I will seek to destroy all **the nations that come against Jerusalem**. And I will pour on the house of David, and on the inhabitants of Jerusalem, the spirit of grace and of supplications: and they (*Israel*) shall look on me whom they (*the nations*) have pierced, and they shall mourn for him, as one mourns for his only son, and shall be in bitterness for him, as one that is in bitterness for his firstborn. In that day shall there be a great mourning in Jerusalem, as the mourning of Hadadrimmon in the valley of Megiddon.

Luke 18:31-33 He took the twelve aside, and said to them, “Behold, we are going up to Jerusalem, and all the things that are written through the prophets concerning the Son of Man will be completed. For he will be delivered up to the Gentiles, will be mocked, treated shamefully, and spit on. They will scourge and kill him. On the third day, he will rise again.”

Genesis 46:5-7 Jacob rose up from Beersheba, and the sons of Israel carried Jacob, their father, their little ones, and their wives, in the wagons which Pharaoh had sent to carry him. They took their livestock, and their goods, which they had gotten in the land of Canaan, and came into Egypt—Jacob, and all his seed with him, his sons, and his sons' sons with him, his daughters, and his sons' daughters, and he brought all his seed with him into Egypt.

Genesis 46:29,30 Joseph prepared his chariot, and went up to meet Israel, his father, in Goshen. He presented himself to him, and fell on his neck, and wept on his neck a good while. Israel said to Joseph, “Now let me die, since I have seen your face, that you are still alive.”

NOTES:

Genesis 37:28 Midianites who were merchants passed by, and they drew and **lifted up** Joseph out of the pit, and sold Joseph to the Ishmaelites for twenty pieces of silver. They brought Joseph into Egypt.

John 12:24 Most certainly I tell you, unless **a grain of wheat falls into the earth and dies**, it remains by itself alone. But if it dies, it bears much fruit.

Genesis 37:24 and they took him, and threw him into the pit. The pit was empty. There was no water in it.

Isaiah 40:3,4 The voice of him that crieth in the wilderness, Prepare ye the way of the LORD,
