Exodus 25:1,2 And the LORD spoke to Moses, saying, Speak to the children of Israel, that they bring me an offering of every man that gives it willingly with his heart you shall take my offering.

Exodus 25:3-7 And this is the offering <terumah>: which you shall take of them; gold, and silver, and brass, And blue, and purple, and scarlet, and fine linen, and goats 'hair, And rams' skins dyed red, and badgers 'skins, and shittim wood, Oil for the light, spices for anointing oil, and for sweet incense, Onyx stones, and stones to be set in the ephod, and in the breastplate.

Exodus 25:9 According to all that I show you, after the pattern of the tabernacle, and the pattern of all the instruments thereof, even so shall ye make it.

The offering needs to be according to the pattern!

Exodus 26:1 Moreover thou shalt make the tabernacle with ten curtains of fine twined linen, and blue, and purple, and scarlet: with cherubims of cunning work shalt thou make them.

Exodus 26:3-5 The **five curtains** shall be coupled together one to another; and other **five** curtains shall be coupled one to another. And you shall make loops of blue on the edge of the one curtain from the selvedge in the coupling; and likewise shall you make in the uttermost edge of another curtain, in the coupling of the second. Fifty loops shall you make in the one curtain, and fifty loops shall you make in the edge of the curtain that is in the coupling of the second; that the loops may take hold one of another.

Exodus 26:36,37 And you shall make an hanging for the door of the tent, of blue, and purple, and scarlet, and fine twined linen, worked with needlework. And you shall make for the hanging five pillars of shittim wood, and overlay them with gold, and their **hooks** shall be of gold: and you shall cast five sockets of brass for them.

Exodus 40:18 And Moses reared up the tabernacle, and fastened his sockets, and set up the boards thereof, and put in the bars thereof, and reared up his **pillars**.

Exodus 25:8 And let them make Me a **sanctuary**, that I may dwell **among them**.

Luke 17:21 Neither shall they say, Lo here! or, lo there! for, behold, the kingdom of God **is within you**.

2Corinthians 6:16 And what agreement has the temple of God with idols? for you are the temple of the living God; as God has said, I will dwell in them, and walk in them; and I will be their God, and they shall be my people.

Revelation 21:1-3 I saw a new heaven and a new earth: for the first heaven and the first earth have passed away, and the sea is no more. I saw the holy city, New Jerusalem, coming down out of heaven from God, prepared like a bride adorned for her husband. I heard a loud voice out of heaven saying, "Behold, God's dwelling is with people, and he will dwell with them, and they will be his people, and God himself will be with them as their God.

1Corinthians 12:27 Now **you are the body of Messiah**, and members individually.

1Peter 2:4-6 Coming to him, a **living stone**, rejected indeed by men, but chosen by God, precious. You also, as living stones, are built up as a spiritual house, to be a holy priesthood, to offer up spiritual sacrifices, acceptable to God through Yeshua the Messiah. Because it is contained in Scripture, "Behold, I lay in Zion a chief cornerstone, chosen, and precious: He who believes in him will not be disappointed."

2Timothy 2:20,21 Now in a large house there are not only vessels of gold and of silver, but also of wood and of clay. Some are for honor, and some for dishonor. If anyone therefore purges himself from these, he will be a vessel for honor, sanctified, and suitable for the master's use, prepared for every good work.

NOTES:

Exodus 25:8 they were to build a **sanctuary**

Amos 7:4-9 Thus the Lord GOD showed me and behold, the Lord GOD called for judgment by fire; and it dried up the great deep, and would have devoured the land. Then I said, "Lord GOD, stop, I beg you! How could Jacob stand? For he is small." The LORD relented concerning this. "This also shall not be," says the Lord GOD. Thus he showed me and behold, the Lord stood beside a wall made by a **plumb line, with a plumb line in his hand**. The LORD said to me, "Amos, what do you see?" I said, "A plumb line." Then the Lord said, "Behold, I will set a plumb line in the midst of my people Israel. I will not again pass by them any more. The high places of Isaac will be desolate, the sanctuaries of Israel will be laid waste; and I will rise against the house of Jeroboam with the sword."

Exodus 29:46 And they shall know that I am the Lord their God, that **brought them forth out of the land of Egypt, that I may dwell among them**: I am the Lord their God.

Psalms 104:1,2 Bless the Lord, O my soul. O Lord my God, you are very great; you are clothed with honor and majesty. Who cover yourself with light as with a garment: **who stretch out the heavens like a curtain**.

Exodus 26:7a And you shall make **curtains** of goats' hair to be a covering on the tabernacle...

Genesis 1:6 And God said, Let there be a firmament in the middle of the waters, and **let it divide** the waters from the waters.

Exodus 26:33 And you shall hang up the veil under the clasps, that you may bring in thither within the veil the ark of the testimony: and the veil shall **divide** to you between the holy place and the most holy.

Genesis 1:9a And God said, Let **the waters under the heaven be gathered** together to one place..

Exodus 30:18 You shall also **make a laver of brass**, and his foot also of brass, to wash with: and you shall put it between the tabernacle of the congregation and the altar, and you shalt **put water therein**.

Genesis 1:14 And God said, Let **there be lights** in the firmament of the heaven to divide the day from the night and let them be for signs, and for seasons, and for days, and years.

Exodus 25:31 And you shall **make a candlestick** of pure gold: of beaten work shall the candlestick be made: his shaft, and his branches, his bowls, his knops, and his flowers, shall be of the same..

NOTES:

Genesis 1:20 And God said, Let the waters bring forth abundantly the moving creature that has life, and **fowl that may fly above the earth** in the open firmament of heaven

Exodus 25:20 And the **cherubim shall stretch forth their wings on high**, covering the mercy seat with their wings, and their faces shall look one to another; toward the mercy seat shall the faces of the cherubim be.

Genesis 1:27 So God created man in his own image, in the image of God created he him; male and female created he them.

Exodus 28:1 And take you unto you **Aaron your brother, and his sons** with him, from among **the children** of Israel, that he may minister to me in the priest's office.

Genesis 2:1-3 Thus the heavens and the earth were finished, and all the host of them. And on the seventh day God ended his work which he had made; and **he rested on the seventh day** from all his work which he had made. And **God blessed** the seventh day, and **sanctified it**: because that in it he had rested from all his work which God created and made.

Numbers 7:1 And it came to pass on the day that Moses had fully set up the tabernacle, and had anointed it, and sanctified it, and all the instruments thereof, both the altar and all the vessels thereof, and had anointed them, and **sanctified them**.

Exodus 39:43 And Moses did look upon all the work, and, behold, they had done it as the Lord had commanded, even so had they done it: and **Moses blessed them**.

Genesis 3:24 So he drove out the man; and he placed **at the east** of the garden of Eden Cherubim, and a flaming sword which turned every way, to keep the way of the tree of life.

Numbers 2:3 And **on the east side** toward the rising of the sun shall they of the standard of the camp of Judah pitch throughout their armies: and Nahshon the son of Amminadab shall be captain of the children of Judah.

Haftarah

1Kings 11:42 And the time that Solomon reigned in Jerusalem over all Israel was forty years.

1Kings 3:1 And Solomon made **affinity** with Pharaoh king of Egypt, and took Pharaoh's daughter, and brought her into the city of David, until he had made an end of building his own house, and the house of the Lord, and the wall of Jerusalem round about.

NOTES:

Esther 8:12-17 On one day in all the provinces of king Ahasuerus, namely, on the thirteenth day of the twelfth month, which is the month Adar. The copy of the writing for a commandment to be given in every province was published to all people, and that the Jews should be ready against that day to avenge themselves on their enemies. So the posts that rode on mules and camels went out, being hastened and pressed on by the king's commandment. And the decree was given at Shushan the palace. And Mordecai went out from the presence of the king in royal apparel of blue and white, and with a great crown of gold, and with a garment of fine linen and purple: and the city of Shushan rejoiced and was glad. The Jews had light, and gladness, and joy, and honor. And in every province, and in every city, wherever the king's commandment and his decree came, the Jews had joy and gladness, a feast and a good day. And many of the people of the land became Jews; for the fear of the Jews fell on them.

1Kings 5:4 But now the LORD my God has given me rest on every side, so that there is neither adversary nor evil result.

1Kings 6:37,38 In the fourth year was the foundation of the house of the LORD laid, in the month Zif: And in the eleventh year, in the month Bul, which is the eighth month, was the house finished throughout all the parts thereof, and according to all the fashion of it. So was he seven years in building it.

1Kings 7:1 But Solomon was building his own house thirteen years, and he finished all his house.

1Kings 9:10 And it came to pass at the end of twenty years, when Solomon had built the two houses, the house of the LORD, and the king's house,

1Kings 7:8b Solomon made also an house for Pharaoh's daughter, whom he had taken to wife, like to this porch.

1Kings 11:7-14 Then did Solomon build an high place for Chemosh, the abomination of Moab, in the hill that is before Jerusalem, and for Molech, the abomination of the children of Ammon. And likewise did he for all his strange wives, which burnt incense and sacrificed to their gods. And the LORD was angry with Solomon, because his heart was turned from the LORD God of Israel, which had appeared to him twice, And had commanded him concerning this thing, that he should not go after other gods: but he kept not that which the LORD commanded. Why the LORD said to Solomon, For as much as this is done of you, and you have not kept my covenant and my statutes, which I have commanded you, I will surely rend the kingdom from you, and will give it to your servant. Notwithstanding in your days I will not do it for David your father's sake: but I will rend it out of the hand of your son. However, I will not rend away all the kingdom; but will give one tribe to your son for David my servant's sake, and for Jerusalem's sake which I have chosen. And the LORD stirred up an adversary to Solomon, Hadad the Edomite: he was of the king's seed in Edom.

NOTES:

1Kings 11:23-26 And God stirred him up another adversary, Rezon the son of Eliadah, which fled from his lord Hadadezer king of Zobah: And he gathered men to him, and became captain over a band, when David slew them of Zobah: and they went to Damascus, and dwelled therein, and reigned in Damascus. And he was an adversary to Israel all the days of Solomon, beside the mischief that Hadad did: and he abhorred Israel, and reigned over Syria. And Jeroboam the son of Nebat, an Ephrathite of Zereda, Solomon's servant, whose mother's name was Zeruah, a widow woman, even he lifted up his hand against the king.

Mark 12:36,37 For David himself said in the Holy Spirit, 'The Lord said to my Lord, "Sit at my right hand, until I make your enemies the footstool of your feet.'" Therefore David himself calls him Lord, so how can he be his son?"

Psalms 110:1 The LORD says to my Lord, "Sit at my right hand, until I make your enemies your footstool for your feet."

Micah 5:2 But you, Bethlehem Ephrathah, being small among the clans of Judah, out of you one will come forth to me that is to be ruler in Israel; whose goings forth are from of old, from everlasting.
