Yom Kippur

(Day of Atonement)

2Peter 3:13 Nevertheless we, according to his promise, look for <u>new</u> <u>heavens and a new earth</u>, wherein dwelleth righteousness.

Psalms 27:7-9 Hear, O LORD, when I cry with my voice: have mercy also upon me, and answer me. When thou saidst, Seek ye my face; my heart said unto thee, Thy face, LORD, will I seek. Hide not thy face far from me; put not thy servant away in anger: thou hast been my help; leave me not, neither forsake me, O God of my salvation.

Leviticus 16:29-34 And this shall be a statute for ever unto you: that in the seventh month, on the tenth day of the month, ye shall afflict your souls, and do no work at all, whether it be one of your own country, or a stranger that so journeth among you: For on that day shall the priest make an atonement for you, to cleanse you, that ye may be clean from all your sins before the LORD. It shall be a sabbath of rest unto you, and ye shall afflict your souls, by a statute for ever. And the priest, whom he shall anoint, and whom he shall consecrate to minister in the priest's office in his father's stead, shall make the atonement, and shall put on the linen clothes, even the holy garments: And he shall make an atonement for the holy sanctuary, and he shall make an atonement for the tabernacle of the congregation, and for the altar, and he shall make an atonement for the priests, and for all the people of the congregation. And this shall be an everlasting statute unto you, to make an atonement for the children of Israel for all their sins once a year. And he did as the LORD commanded Moses.

Numbers 29:7,8 And ye shall have on the tenth day of this seventh month an holy convocation; and ye shall afflict your souls: ye shall not do any work therein: But ye shall offer a burnt offering unto the LORD for a sweet savour; one young bullock, one ram, and seven lambs of the first year; they shall be unto you without blemish:

Isaiah 57:15 For thus saith the high and lofty One that inhabiteth eternity, whose name is Holy; I dwell in the high and holy place, with him also that is of a contrite and humble spirit, to revive the spirit of the humble, and to revive the heart of the contrite ones.

Isaiah 58:6,7 Is not this the fast that I have chosen? To loose the bands of wickedness, to undo the heavy burdens, and to let the oppressed go free, and that ye break every yoke? Is it not to deal thy bread to the hungry, and that thou bring the poor that are cast out to thy house? When thou seest the naked, that thou cover him; and that thou hide not thyself from thine own flesh?

Isaiah 58:13,14 If thou turn away thy foot from the sabbath, from doing thy pleasure on my holy day; and call the sabbath a delight, the holy of the LORD, honourable; and shalt honour him, not doing thine own ways, nor finding thine own pleasure, nor speaking thine own words: Then shalt thou delight thyself in the LORD; and I will cause thee to ride upon the high places of the earth, and feed thee with the heritage of Jacob thy father: for the mouth of the LORD hath spoken it.

Jonah 1:1,2 Now the word of the LORD came unto Jonah the son of Amittai, saying, Arise, go to Nineveh, that great city, and cry against it; for their wickedness is come up before me.

Though everyone knows that a large fish swallowed Jonah, the message of Jonah is actually a timeless lesson in the power of *repentance* and God's desire to help mankind rather than punish him.

Jonah 1:3-6 And Jonah <u>riseth</u> to flee to Tarshish from <u>the face of Jehovah</u>, and goeth down to Joppa, and findeth a ship going to Tarshish, and he giveth its fare, and goeth down into it, to go with them to Tarshish <u>from the face of Jehovah</u>. And Jehovah hath cast a great wind on the sea, and there is a great tempest in the sea, and the ship hath reckoned to be broken; and the mariners are afraid, and cry each unto his god, and cast the goods that are in the ship into the sea, to make it light of them; and Jonah hath gone down unto the sides of the vessel, and he lieth down, and <u>is fast asleep</u>. And the chief of the company draweth near to him, and saith to him, 'What <u>arise</u>, O sleeper? <u>rise</u>, call unto thy God, it may be God doth bethink himself of us, and we do not perish.'

Ephesians 5:14 Wherefore he saith, Awake thou that sleepest, and arise from the dead, and Messiah shall give thee light.

Leviticus 25:9 Then shalt thou cause the trumpet of the jubilee to sound on the <u>tenth day of the seventh month</u>, in the day of atonement shall ye make the trumpet sound throughout all your land.

May the ultimate trumpet of the Jubilee to be heard soon in our day!

Leviticus 23:27 Also on the <u>tenth day</u> of this <u>seventh month</u> there shall be <u>a day of atonement</u>: it shall be an <u>holy convocation</u> unto you; and ye shall afflict your souls, and offer an offering made by fire unto the LORD.

John 1:29 The next day John seeth Jesus coming unto him, and saith, Behold the Lamb of God, which taketh away the sin of the world.

Psalms 103:12 As far as the east is from the west, so far hath he remain transgressions from us.

Micah 7:19 He will turn again, he will have compassion upon us; he will subdue our iniquities; and thou wilt cast all their sins into the <u>depths of</u> the sea.

Isaiah 11:9-12 They shall not hurt nor destroy in all my holy mountain: for the earth shall be full of the knowledge of the LORD, as the waters cover the sea. And in that day there shall be a root of Jesse, which shall stand for an ensign of the people; to it shall the Gentiles seek: and his rest shall be glorious. And it shall come to pass in that day, that the Lord shall set his hand again the second time to recover the remnant of his people, which shall be left, from Assyria, and from Egypt, and from..... And he shall set up an ensign for the nations, and shall assemble the outcasts of Israel, and gather together the dispersed of Judah from the four corners of the earth.

Zechariah 3:9 For behold the stone that I have laid before Joshua; upon one stone shall be seven eyes: behold, I will engrave the graving thereof, saith the LORD of hosts, and \underline{I} will remove the iniquity of that land in one \underline{day} .

What a glorious promise! Yom Kippur, the Day of Atonement, will be fulfilled one day in Jerusalem through the Messiah. All Israel will be saved and the Land will be cleansed from all sin and impurity. After that the new Temple will be rebuilt and from there the Messiah will take up his throne and reign over Israel and over all of the world.

We read in greater detail about the fulfillment of the Day of Atonement for Israel in Ezekiel 36.

Notice how this is described in Ezekiel 36,

Ezekiel 36:1-5 Also, thou son of man, prophesy unto the mountains of Israel, and say, Ye mountains of Israel, hear the word of the LORD: Thus saith the Lord GOD; Because the enemy hath said against you, Aha, even the ancient high places are ours in possession: Therefore prophesy and say, Thus saith the Lord GOD; Because they have made you desolate, and swallowed you up on every side, that ye might be a possession unto the residue of the heathen, and ye are taken up in the lips of talkers, and are an infamy of the people:

Therefore, ye mountains of Israel, hear the word of the Lord GOD; that are round about;

Therefore thus saith the Lord GOD; Surely in the fire of my jealousy have I spoken against the residue of the heathen, and against all Idumea, which have appointed my land into their possession with the joy of all their heart, with despiteful minds, to cast it out for a prey.

Ezekiel 36:8-12 But ye, O mountains of Israel, ye shall shoot forth your branches, and yield your fruit to my people of Israel; for they are at hand to come. For, behold, I am for you, and I will turn unto you, and ye shall be tilled and sown: And I will multiply men upon you, all the house of Israel, even all of it: and the cities shall be inhabited, and the wastes shall be builded:

And I will multiply upon you man and beast; and they shall increase and bring fruit: and I will settle you after your old estates, and will do better unto you than at your beginnings: and ye shall know that I am the LORD. Yea, I will cause men to walk upon you, even my people Israel; and they shall possess thee, and thou shalt be their inheritance, and thou shalt no more henceforth bereave them of men.

Ezekiel 36:19-24 And I scattered them among the heathen, and they were dispersed through the countries: according to their way and according to their doings I judged them. And when they entered unto the heathen, whither they went, they profaned my holy name, when they said to them, These are the people of the LORD, and are gone forth out of his land.

But I had pity for mine holy name, which the house of Israel had profaned among the heathen, whither they went. Therefore say unto the house of Israel, Thus saith the Lord GOD; I do not this for your sakes, O house of Israel, but for mine holy name's sake, which ye have profaned among the heathen, whither ye went.

And I will sanctify my great name, which was profaned among the heathen, which ye have profaned in the midst of them; and the heathen shall know that I am the LORD, saith the Lord GOD, when I shall be sanctified in you before their eyes. For I will take you from among the heathen, and gather you out of all countries, and will bring you into your own land.

Notice that the salvation and restoration of Israel is connected to the sanctification of God's holy name. "It is not for your sake, O house of Israel, that I am going to do these things, but for the sake of my holy name, Then the nations will know that I am the LORD."

The entire passage ends with this promise,

Ezekiel 36:37,38 This is what the Lord has said: The children of <u>Israel</u> will again make prayer to me for this, that I may do it for them; I will make them increased with men like a flock. Like sheep for the offerings, like the sheep of Jerusalem at her fixed feasts, so the unpeopled towns will be made full of men: and they will be certain that I am the Lord.

In other words, God is going to fulfill all the promises in answer to prayer! Real prayer is not trying to change God's mind, but to aggressively lay hold of His will, just as Yeshua taught us,

Matthew 6:9,10 After this manner therefore pray ye: Our Father which art in heaven, Hallowed be thy name. Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done in earth, as it is in heaven.

Our priority is to pray for God's glory to be revealed, that his kingdom will come and his will be done on the earth. It can also be translated "...your will be done in the Land," i.e. the Land of Israel.

The salvation of Israel will be life from the dead for the world.

Romans 11:15 For if the casting away of them be the reconciling of the world, what shall the receiving of them be, but life from the dead?

Now here in Revelations we see a Divine Appointment happening and it is the Yom Kippur service! This event will happen some year on Yom Kippur!

Revelations 8:3-6 And another angel came and stood at the altar, having a golden censer; and there was given unto him much incense, that he should offer it with the prayers of all saints upon the golden altar which was before the throne. And the smoke of the incense, which came with the prayers of the saints, ascended up before God out of the angel's hand. And the angel took the censer, and filled it with fire of the altar, and cast it into the earth: and there were voices, and thunderings, and lightnings, and an earthquake. And the seven angels which had the seven trumpets prepared themselves to sound.

Isaiah 63:1-4 Who is this that cometh from Edom, with dyed garments from Bozrah? This that is glorious in his apparel, travelling in the greatness of his strength? I that speak in righteousness, mighty to save. Wherefore art thou red in thine apparel, and thy garments like him that treadeth in the winefat? I have trodden the winepress alone; and of the people there was none with me: for I will tread them in mine anger, and trample them in my fury; and their blood shall be sprinkled upon my garments, and I will stain all my raiment. For the day of vengeance is in mine heart, and the year of my redeemed is come.

Revelations 19:2,13-15 For true and righteous are his judgments: for he hath judged the great whore, which did corrupt the earth with her fornication, and <u>hath avenged the blood</u> of his servants at her hand. And he was clothed with <u>a vesture dipped in blood</u>: and his name is called The Word of God. And the armies which were in heaven followed him upon white horses, clothed in fine linen, white and clean.

And out of his mouth goeth a sharp sword, that with it he should smite the nations: and he shall rule them with a rod of iron: and he <u>treadeth</u> the <u>winepress</u> of the fierceness and wrath of Almighty God.

Matthew 13:39 38 The field is the world; the good seed are the children of the kingdom; but the tares are the children of the wicked one; The enemy that sowed them is the devil; the harvest is the end of the world; and the reapers are the angels.

Exodus 23:16 And the feast of <u>harvest</u>, the firstfruits of thy labours, which thou hast sown in the field: and the <u>feast of ingathering</u>, which is in the <u>end of the year</u>, when thou hast gathered in thy labours <u>out of</u> the field.

Revelations 14:18 And another <u>angel came</u> out from the altar, which had power over fire; and cried with a loud cry to him that had the sharp sickle, saying, <u>Thrust in thy sharp sickle</u>, and <u>gather the clusters</u> of the vine of the earth; for <u>her grapes</u> are fully ripe.

Leviticus 16:16,17 And he shall make an atonement for the holy place, because of the uncleanness of the children of Israel, and because of their transgressions in all their sins: and so shall he do for the tabernacle of the congregation, that remaineth among them in the midst of their uncleanness. And there shall be no man in the tabernacle of the congregation when he goeth in to make an atonement in the holy place, until he come out, and have made an atonement for himself, and for his household, and for all the congregation of Israel.

Revelations 15:8 And the temple was filled with smoke from the glory of God, and from his power; and no man was able to enter into the temple, till the seven plaques of the seven angels were fulfilled.

PROPHETIC FOR ISRAEL

Prophetically on this day Israel as a nation will realize Yeshua is their Messiah! This day was the only day the High Priest could speak to God "face to Face".

Ezekiel 20:33-35 As I live, saith the Lord GOD, surely with a mighty hand, and with a stretched out arm, and with fury poured out, will I rule over you: And I will bring you out from the people, and will gather you out of the countries wherein ye are scattered, with a mighty hand, and with a stretched out arm, and with fury poured out. And \underline{I} will bring you into the wilderness of the people, and there will I plead with you face to face.

Isaiah 25:7,8 And he will destroy in this mountain the face of the covering cast over all people, and the vail that is spread over all nations. He will swallow up death in victory; and the Lord GOD will wipe away tears from off all faces; and the rebuke of his people shall he take away from off all the earth: for the LORD hath spoken it.

Most of the church today has a veil over their faces concerning the eternal plan God has for the Jews. The veil consists of 2 main parts:

- 1. Inability to recognize God's purpose for the Jews
- 2. Inability to understand the Church's role for the removing of that veil

God will remove the veil from both groups but is waiting for something significant to happen.

Yom Kippur was the only day the High Priest could speak to God "Face to Face".

Hosea 5:15-6:3 I will go and return to my place, till they acknowledge their offence, and seek my face: in their affliction they will seek me early. Come, and let us return unto the LORD: for he hath torn, and he will heal us; he hath smitten, and he will bind us up. After two days will he revive us: in the third day he will raise us up, and we shall live in his sight. Then shall we know, if we follow on to know the LORD: his going forth is prepared as the morning; and he shall come unto us as the rain, as the latter and former rain unto the earth.

Genesis 42:21 And they said one to another, We are verily guilty concerning our brother, in that we saw the anguish of his soul, when he besought us, and we would not hear; therefore is this distress come upon us.

Genesis 43:3,9 And Judah spake unto him, saying, The man did solemnly protest unto us, saying, Ye shall not see my face, except your brother be with you. I will be surety for him; of my hand shalt thou require him: if I bring him not unto thee, and set him before thee, then let me bear the blame for ever:

Genesis 44:16,33,34 And Judah said, What shall we say unto my lord? what shall we speak? or how shall we clear ourselves? God hath found out the iniquity of thy servants: behold, we are my lord's servants, both we, and he also with whom the cup is found. / Now therefore, I pray thee, let thy servant abide instead of the lad a bondman to my lord; and let the lad go up with his brethren. For how shall I go up to my father, and the lad be not with me? lest peradventure I see the evil that shall come on my father.

Genesis 45:1,2 Then Joseph could not refrain himself before all them the by him; and he cried, Cause every man to go out from me. And there stood with him, while Joseph made himself known unto his brethren. And he were and the Egyptians and the house of Pharaoh heard.

Kol Nidre always began with this statement:

In the tribunal of Heaven and the tribunal of earth, by the permission of God — praised be He — and by the permission of this holy congregation, we hold it lawful to pray with transgressors."
