

2011 YOM TERUAH

Nehemiah 8:1-3 And all the people gathered themselves together as one man into the street that was before the water gate; and they spake unto Ezra the scribe to bring the book of the law of Moses, which the LORD had commanded to Israel. And Ezra the priest brought the law before the congregation both of men and women, and all that could hear with understanding, upon the first day of the seventh month. And he read therein before the street that was before the water gate from the morning until midday, before the men and the women, and those that could understand; and the ears of all the people were attentive unto the book of the law.

Nehemiah 8:5,6 And Ezra opened the book in the sight of all the people; (for he was above all the people;) and when he opened it, all the people stood up: And Ezra blessed the LORD, the great God. And all the people answered, Amen, Amen, with lifting up their hands: and they bowed their heads, and worshipped the LORD with their faces to the ground.

Nehemiah 8:8 So they read in the book in the law of God distinctly, and gave the sense, and caused them to understand the reading.

Leviticus 23:1,2 And the LORD spake unto Moses, saying, Speak unto the children of Israel, and say unto them, Concerning the Feasts **מועד** of the LORD, which ye shall proclaim **קרא** to be holy convocations, **מקרא** even these are *My feasts*.

4150 מועד mo-ade' an appointment, specifically, a festival; an assembly (as convened for a definite purpose); also a signal (as appointed beforehand):

7121 קרא kaw-raw' the idea of accosting a person met; to call out to (i.e. properly, address by name,

4744 מיקרא mik-raw' from 7121; something called out, i.e. a public meeting (the act, the persons, or the place); also a rehearsal: (Heaven is rehearsing as well!)

Leviticus 23:24 Speak unto the children of Israel, saying, In the seventh month, in the first day of the month, shall ye have a sabbath, a memorial of blowing of trumpets, an holy convocation.

2146 זכרון zikrown, a memento

If the Lord has no remembrance of a person or nation they have been rejected:

Luke 13:25-27 When once the master of the house is risen up, and hath shut to the door, and ye begin to stand without, and to knock at the door, saying, Lord, Lord, open unto us; and he shall answer and say unto you, I know you not whence ye are: Then shall ye begin to say, We have eaten and drunk in thy presence, and thou hast taught in our streets. But he shall say, I tell you, I know you not whence ye are; depart from me, all ye workers of iniquity.

Numbers 29:1 And in the seventh month, on the first day of the month, ye shall have an holy convocation; ye shall do no servile work: it is a day of blowing the trumpets unto you. (Yom Teruah)

8643 תרועה ter-oo-aw' from 7321; clamor, i.e. acclamation of joy or a battle-cry; especially clangor of trumpets, as an alarm:--alarm, blow(-ing) (of, the) (trumpets), joy, jubilee, loud noise, rejoicing, shout(-ing), (high, joyful) sound(-ing).

7321 רוע ruwa` , to split the ears (with sound), i.e. shout (for joy), sound an alarm, triumph.

Psalms 47:5 God is gone up with a shout, **תרועה** the LORD with the sound of a trumpet. (Shopfar **שופר**)

1Thessalonians 4:16 For the Lord himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of God:

Psalms 89:15 Blessed is the people that know the joyful sound: hewrt they shall walk, O LORD, in the light of thy countenance.

Tekiah - *One long straight blast - Announce God is our King! He runs the world, He's the one who guides history. For many of us the idea of a king conjures up images of a greedy power hungry despot who wants to subjugate the masses for his selfish aims.*

Shevarim - *Three short blasts - the sobbing cry of the heart yearning to reconnect with God.*

Teruah - *Nine staccato blasts - resembles an alarm clock arousing us from our spiritual slumber. We need to wake up and be honest with ourselves.*

1Corinthians 15:52 In a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trump: for the trumpet shall sound, and the dead shall be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed.

Ha Kiddushin/Nesuin (Wedding of the Messiah) The Bible is a marriage covenant
Joel 2:15...16 Blow the trumpet in Zion, sanctify a fast, call a solemn assembly... let the bridegroom go forth of his chamber, and the bride out of her closet.

OT:2646 closet / chuppah (khood-paw'); from OT:2645; a canopy:

Matthew 22:1-5 And Jesus answered and spake unto them again by parables, and said, The kingdom of heaven is like unto a certain king, which made a marriage for his son, And sent forth his servants to call them that were bidden to the wedding: and they would not come. Again, he sent forth other servants, saying, Tell them which are bidden, Behold, I have prepared my dinner: my oxen and my fatlings are killed, and all things are ready: come unto the marriage. But they made light of it, and went their ways, one to his farm, another to his merchandise:

Matthew 22:8-11 Then saith he to his servants, The wedding is ready, but they which were bidden were not worthy. Go ye therefore into the highways, and as many as ye shall find, bid to the marriage. So those servants went out into the highways, and gathered together all as many as they found, both bad and good: and the wedding was furnished with guests. And when the king came in to see the guests, he saw there a man which had not on a wedding garment:

Zephaniah 1:6-8 And them that are turned back from the LORD; and those that have not sought the LORD, nor enquired for him. Hold thy peace at the presence of the Lord GOD: for the day of the LORD is at hand: for the LORD hath prepared a sacrifice, he hath bid his guests. And it shall come to pass in the day of the LORD'S sacrifice, that I will punish the princes, and the king's children, and all such as are clothed with strange apparel.

Zephaniah 1:14-16 The great day of the LORD is near, it is near, and hasteth greatly, even the voice of the day of the LORD: the mighty man shall cry there bitterly. That day

is a day of wrath, a day of trouble and distress, a day of wasteness and desolation, a day of darkness and gloominess, a day of clouds and thick darkness, A day of the trumpet and alarm

Ha Melech (Coronation of the Messiah)

Psalms 47:1-4 O clap your hands, all ye people; shout unto God with the voice of triumph. For the LORD most high is terrible; he is a great King over all the earth. He shall subdue the people under us, and the nations under our feet. He shall choose our inheritance for us, the excellency of Jacob whom he loved. Selah.

Psalms 47:5-7 God is gone up with a shout, the LORD with the sound of a trumpet. Sing praises to God, sing praises: sing praises unto our King, sing praises. For God is the King of all the earth: sing ye praises with understanding.

Psalms 47:8,9 God reigneth over the heathen: God sitteth upon the throne of his holiness. The princes of the people are gathered together, even the people of the God of Abraham: for the shields of the earth belong unto God: he is greatly exalted.

Psalms 102:13 Thou shalt arise, and have mercy upon Zion: for the time to favour her, yea, the set time, dewm is come.

Psalms 102:16-18 When the LORD shall build up Zion, he shall appear in his glory. He will regard the prayer of the destitute, and not despise their prayer. This shall be written for the generation to come: and the people which shall be created shall praise the LORD.

Psalms 102:19-22 For he hath looked down from the height of his sanctuary; from heaven did the LORD behold the earth; To hear the groaning of the prisoner; to loose those that are appointed to death; To declare the name of the LORD in Zion, and his praise in Jerusalem; When the people are gathered together, and the kingdoms, to serve the LORD.
