- Cheshvan 17: Flood waters began. Balfour Declaration, 1917.

- Kislev 27: Flood rains cease.
- Kislev 28: Wright Bros. first flight, 1903.

- Tevet 1: Esther made Queen.
- Tevet 4: Mayflower docks at Plymouth Rock, 1620.

- Tevet 10: Beginning of the siege around Jerusalem. King Herod captured Jerusalem. Ezekiel receives prophecy. Deaths of Zechariah and Malachi. Jeremiah buys land and prophesize. Memorial Day for the 6 million Jews killed by the Nazis.
- Tevet 11: War of 1812 ended, 1814.
- Tevet 12: Ezekiel receives prophecy.
- Tevet 18: Massacre at Wounded Knee, 1890.
- Tevet 21: Birth of Simeon.
- Tevet 22: Donald Trump inaugurated, 2017.

Shevat

- Shevat 1: Moses repeats the Torah. Persian Gulf War began, 1991.
- Shevat 4: US 13th Amendment passed the House, 1865.
- Shevat 14: Bloody Sunday, 1972.
- Shevat 15: New Year for Trees. Blue-Blood Moon, 2018. Blood Moon, 2019.
- Shevat 20: Birth of Asher.
- Shevat 23: The Israelites assembled to wage war against the Tribe of Benjamin (as noted in Judges 20:1).
- Shevat 24: The prophet Zechariah predicted the restoration of Zion and encouraged the resumption of the building of the Temple.

- Adar (II) 12: Herod's Temple dedicated.
- Adar (II) 13: Decree went out to kill all the Jews (Book of Esther).
- Adar (II) 14: Moses' circumcision.
- Adar (II) 17: Battle at Alamo ended, 1836.
- Adar (II) 23: The beginning of the seven-day period of assembling the Tabernacle. The Second Temple was dedicated. Crimean War ended, 1856.
- Adar (II) 25: King Nebuchadnezzar dies, 397 BCE. Jehoiachin, King of Judah, released from prison, (Jer. 52:31).
- Adar (II) 27: Zedekiah dies, 397 BCE. Jehoiachin, King of Judah, released from prison (2 Kings 25:27). Spanish Flu began, 1918.
- Adar (II) 29: Total Solar Eclipse, 2015, that happened in the middle of the Blood Moon Tetrad of 2014-15.

- Nissan 1: Tabernacle of the tent of the congregation set up. Death of Nadav & Avihu. The sanctification of the Temple began. Ezra left Babylon for Jerusalem. Ezra and the leaders made an end to the men who took strange wives. Ezekiel receives prophecy. “Black Sunday” aka the Dust Bowl, 1935.
- Nissan 2: Moses performed the first para aduma (Red Heifer) rite.
- Nissan 3: Levites inducted.

- Nissan 15: Death of Job. Jacob wrestles with Angel. People of Israel leave Egypt. Daniel in Lion’s Den. 1st & 3rd Blood Moons of the 2014-15 Tetrad.
- Nissan 16: Birth of Levi. Jews crossed the Jordan into Israel. King Saul’s seven sons were killed. Haman was hanged.
- Nissan 17: The Ark rested on the mountains of Ararat.
- First Fruits: Barley sheaves waved in the temple. Messiah resurrects sometime before morning and appears to disciples.
- Nissan 18: President Lincoln assassinated, 1865.

- Nissan 22: Joshua began his march around Jericho.

- Iyyar 1: Census in the Wilderness. Second Temple construction began. LORD spoke to Moses in Tabernacle.

- Iyyar 4: Columbine shooting, 1999.

- Sivan 3: Three preparatory days of Hagbalah (Boundaries) begin. Six-Day War ended, 1967.
- Sivan 4: Moses writes first 68 chapters of Torah. Lewis & Clark began their expedition, 1804.
- Sivan 5: Reuben finds Mandrakes.
- Sivan 6: Indian Removal Act signed by President Jackson, 1830.
- Sivan 9: People of Israel accept Torah.
- Shavuot: Torah is given at Sinai. Birth and death of King David. The Spirit is poured out on the disciple.
- Sivan 13: Moses ascends Mt. Sinai.
- Sivan 15: Birth and death of Judah. Israelites reach Sinai. D-Day, 1944.
- Sivan 22: Miriam punished with leprosy.
- Sivan 23: Mordechai drafts decree to all Jews of Medo-Persian Empire.
- Sivan 28: Israel arrives in Paran.
- Sivan 29: Twelve spies sent to Canaan.

Tammuz

- Tammuz 1: Waters receded from mountain tops. Birth and death of Joseph. Isaac and family went down to Egypt.
- Tammuz 3: Sun stands still for Joshua.
- Tammuz 5: Ezekiel receives vision while in captivity.
- Tammuz 8: Spanish Inquisition ended, 1834. War of 1812 began, 1812.
- Tammuz 9: Jerusalem was broken up and famine prevailed. Nebuchadnezzar's army breached the walls of Jerusalem.
- Tammuz 10: King Zedekiah was captured by the Babylonians. Korean War began, 1950.
- Tammuz 14-16: Battle of Gettysburg, 1863.
- Tammuz 16: Golden calf made.
- Tammuz 17: Moses breaks the tablets. Temple service disrupted by Babylonian siege. Jerusalem walls breached by Romans. Dire straits begins. King Menashe placed an idol in the Temple. The American colonies declared their independence, 1776.
- Tammuz 18: Golden calf destroyed. Crusades ended, 1291.
- Tammuz 20: French Revolution began, 1789. Temple Mount under Jewish control for the first time since 1961, 2017.

Av

- Av 1: Aaron's death. Death of Elazar, Aaron's son. Ezra came to Jerusalem.
- Av 4: Nehemiah began to build a wall around Jerusalem.
- Av 5: WWI began, 1914.
- Av 7: Nebuzaradan, captain of the guard for Nebuchadnezzar, set fire to Jerusalem, (2 Kings 25:8). First Temple invaded.
- Av 9: The ten spies bring the bad report. First and Second Temple destroyed. Expulsion of the Jews from Spain (1492). Etc.
- Av 10: Birth of Issachar. Nebuzaradan, captain of the guard for Nebuchadnezzar, set fire to Jerusalem, (Jer. 52:12). Elders came to Ezekiel.
- Av 11: Rwanda Genocide ended, 1994.
- Av 14: Battle of Bull Run, 1861.
- Av 15: "The Day of the Breaking of the Ax" when the annual cuttings of firewood for the Temple altar concluded. End of dying in the desert. Tribe of Benjamin re-admitted. Korean War ended, 1953. Blood Moon, 2018.
- Av 18: The western lamp of the Menorah in the Temple was extinguished during the reign of King Achaz.
- Av 24: Crusades began, 1096. Hurricane Katrina, 2005.
- Av 26: Treaty of Cordoba signed, giving Mexico its independence, 1821.
- Av 29: Moses chisels out new stone tablets. Solar Eclipse, 2017.
- Av 30: Moses ascends Sinai to receive the second tablets and God's forgiveness for the people.
